

1. SCHEDULE OF FEES AND SURCHARGES

1.1 MEMBERSHIPS

An ACA membership, individual or clubs, provides benefits not available to non-members (see Policy #8). Memberships end on December 31st.

1.1.1 Individual

Senior/Master Membership (>18)	\$ 25 per year
Youth/Junior Membership (under 18)	\$ 15 per year
One-Day Membership (waived if rider has a 1-day USAC license) (\$3 to ACA \$2 to promoter)	\$ 5 per day
Non-Racing Membership	\$ 20 per year

1.1.2 For racers participating in an ACA competitive event with a USAC One-Day license, the ACA one-day membership fee is waived.

1.1.3 Club Membership \$ 95 per year

1.2 ACA OPERATIONAL SURCHARGES

Definition: An Operational Surcharge is a fee paid by all racers to support the ACA's operational budget.

1.2.1 The operational surcharge to be collected is \$2.50 per rider per day at all weekend (Fri-Sat-Sun/Monday, if holiday) USAC competitive and non-competitive events

1.2.2 The operational surcharge to be collected is \$1.50 per rider per day at all weekday USAC competitive and non-competitive events

1.2.3 Exceptions to Operational Surcharges includes the Juniors Race Free program (see Policy Manual Section 18.1)

1.3 USAC INSURANCE SURCHARGE

This insurance fee is set by USAC, and charged to all USAC individual members and collected by all USAC clubs/event organizers.

1.3.1 \$ 3.00/rider/day at Competitive Events (Road, Track, Cyclocross)

1.3.2 \$ 2.00/rider/day at Gran Fondo events

1.3.3 \$ 1.50/rider/day at Fun Rides and Tours

1.3.4 \$ 1.00/rider/day at Training Rides, Clinics and Camps

1.4 TRANSPONDERS

Active timing chips used at ACA Points Competition events. Life span 3-5 years. Chips are non-transferable.

1.4.1 Purchase Fee

- \$35 when purchased with ACA membership
- \$30 for a rider's additional transponder

1.4.2 Rental Fee

- \$10 per single day event (\$5 goes to club and \$5 to ACA)
- \$15 for stage race and omniums (\$5 goes to club and \$10 to ACA)

1.5 RACE CALENDAR DATE FEES

Definition: A Race Calendar Date fee is a non-refundable fee collected from promoting club/organizer, so that their event is placed on the ACA calendar prior to USAC permit(s) approval. See Policy # 11 for more details.

1.5.1 Basic Fees

- \$25 for single day competitive and non-competitive events
- \$25 for mid-week series events
- \$50 for stage races and omniums

1.5.2 Additional Points Competition Fees

- \$50 Gold level which is payable upon acceptance
- \$25 Silver level which is payable upon acceptance

1.6 RACE KIT DEPOSIT

Kit includes various items to help set up events. The race kit is only available to ACA Member Clubs. See Policy # 12 for details.

- \$350 Refundable Deposit - only available to ACA Member Clubs
- Radio rentals available with Race Kit but for an additional fee

1.7 REGISTRATION SUPPLIES

Supplies typically needed for registration purposes

1.7.1 Race Numbers

- No Charge for ACA Member Clubs (maximum of 800 given at no charge)
- \$ 0.20 / number over 800 for ACA clubs
- \$ 0.25 / number plus \$25 S&H for Non - ACA clubs

1.7.2 Pins

- No Charge for ACA Member Clubs (maximum of 2 boxes)
- \$ 12/box Additional boxes for ACA Member Clubs
- \$ 17/box Non - ACA clubs

1.7.3 NCR Forms (triplicate race registration forms)

- No Charge ACA member Club (maximum of 50 sheets)
- \$ 25 Non-ACA Members

1.7.4 ACA Registration software available to ACA Member Clubs at No Charge.

1.8 D&L-ACA TIMING SYSTEM

A world class electronic timing system that integrates the use of high speed finish cameras and timing chip transponders. See Policy #14 for more details.

1.8.1 Single Day events

- \$800 ACA Member Clubs
- \$1200 Non-ACA clubs

1.8.2 Multiple Day events

- TDB on a case to case basis

1.8.3 Mileage charges apply for distances greater than 120 miles from Denver, CO

1.9 OFFICIALS FEES

Officials Fees are based on the highest race category (which is based on prize list) plus the cost of reasonable and necessary travel.

1.9.1 Minimum Fees

1.9.2 The work day shall begin when the official arrives at the site and will end at the time of departure.

1.9.3 Mileage to and from the official's home and during the race will determine what is to be charged. Organizers shall also pay the IRS business mileage rate to, during, and from venue inspection.

1.9.4 The organizer is responsible to provide housing and meals if an overnight stay is necessary before, during, or after the race.

2012 ACA Schedule of Fees and Surcharges

- 1.9.5 The organizer must provide each official with a meal and liquid refreshments for officials who work more than five hours during an event day. If meal(s) are not provided, the organizer shall pay an additional \$15.00 for a single day event and \$25.00 per day for Stage/Series/Omniums races to each official.
- 1.9.6 A Chief Referee may charge a \$25.00 plus mileage for a site visit if the Chief Referee feels that such a visit is necessary. If an overnight stay is required, housing and a per diem of \$25 are required.
- 1.9.7 In case a race is canceled after officials have begun their travel, officials will receive mileage plus \$25.
