Location:

North Area Athletic Complex (NAAC) –
19500 W. 64th Parkway, Arvada

From Kipling north, follow 64th Avenue west to 64th Parkway to Highway 93. Stadium is on the SE corner of 64th Parkway and Highway 93. Turn east to stadium. Or, take Hwy. 93 north from Golden to 64th Pkwy, and turn east.

Registration:

Pre-Registration is now available at <http://www.runningguru.com/EventInformation.asp?eID=83> . Avoid registration lines by pre-registering. You will still need to sign a waiver at registration. All riders must hold an ACA license – please bring it to registration! One day licenses will be available the day of the event. No annual licenses will be sold at the event – so buck up and buy it now if you don't already have one. Cash or checks only for day of registration – payable to ICCC. Juniors Race Free – it is \$10 more if you want to race in a second race.

Course:

This is a new venue that you will be sure to love! It is wide open so spectators can watch the race develop. There are wide open sections, set up for power and passing, and tight technical sections to test your bike handling skills. There is some bumpy pavement and just some cool stuff as always. Race goes rain, snow (hopefully) or shine.

Prizes & Categories:

This is States! So you can look forward to wearing the flashy State Champion CX jacket when you cross the line first. We also have a limited edition **Outlaw Earth** messenger bag for those adult winners that will be wearing the jacket. Beyond that, we will have the usual gift certificates and etc as prizes. To be eligible for Colorado State Championship medals and/or vest you must hold a current annual ACA license, and must have continuously resided in Colorado for the past six (6) months.

We will also have a **Clydesdale** class. Here is the deal – you step on the scales with your bike and the both of you need to measure over 220 pounds together. So that means a 180 pound person with a 41 pound bike can race – We will let you do the math. The first place Clyde will get the cool Outlaw Earth bag. This is NOT a state championship event so no state medal or vest will be awarded.

Kiddie Kross is also making an appearance, where the future crossers will race on their own course – hopefully Sid the Snake Barrier will be present. This is for the 8 and under crowd.

All the kids that race will get a medal as they should. For other categories, whatever prizes we get from our sponsors, we will pass onto the categories. For the Men's and Women's Open races, we will give a percentage of the entry fees for that race back as a prize – in other words, more entrants equals more prize money.

Other Info: CX racing age determined by your age on 12/31/10. This is one year older than your current road racing age.

All racers must report 10-min. before their start time for call-ups. Call-ups will be based on ACA guidelines. Annual licenses will NOT be sold- only 1-Day licenses available for \$10.
