NEW SCHEDULE!

Friday: Time Trial – 8-mile out and back, 240 feet of elevation, one hill

Saturday: Criterium – 1-mile flat figure-eight course in downtown Salida

Sunday: Road Race - challenging 5.7 mile circuit with approximately 500 feet climbing each lap

Special Events on Saturday during the Criterium: Farmer's Market, Amicas Beer/Pizza tent, and Single Speed Criterium (fundraiser for the Mentors Program). Accommodations and local attractions: www.salidachamber.org.

Rules: All riders will be scored for the Omnium. Senior and Masters BAR/BAT for Omnium overall. Juniors will score Omnium points for time trial and road race. BAR/BAT for Omnium overall for Juniors. Omnium points and rules per ACA Section 20. You do not need to race all 3 events to be eligible for the Omnium overall. TT start times are approximate. Actual start times posted at registration. Helmets are mandatory. Yellow-line rule will be enforced. No littering on the courses. Road course will not be closed to traffic. Results posted at Alpine Park.

Registration: Register online at www.southcentralracing.com. Onsite registration and check-in: Alpine Park, located at 4th and "F" Streets, downtown Salida. You must pre-register for the Omnium, Time Trial and Road Race. Onsite registration is available for the Criterium *only* and CLOSSES 1 HOUR PRIOR TO THE START OF EACH RACE. Fees: \$105 for Omnium; \$30 time trial; \$35 Criterium; and \$45 road race. Junior Fee: \$20 for one event, \$35 for Omnium (Time Trial and Road Race only). \$10 for 2nd Criterium. Race fees include ACA and insurance fees. \$10 for one-day ACA license. Online registration closes Tuesday at midnight MDT. After that, \$10 late fee for Criterium. Online registrations are subject to a \$3.00 processing fee. **Junior Scholarship Program:** a limited number of scholarships will be available to help cover the cost of the Omnium registration fee for Juniors. From Colorado Springs: Hwy 50 West to Salida, turn right onto "H" Street and continue to end.

From Denver: Hwy 285 south, turn left (east) on Hwy 291. Once in Salida, turn right on "G" St. (south), go 2 blocks to 3rd St.

IMPORTANT Parking: There will be very limited parking. Please use the public parking lot adjacent to Safeway location.
