7:00 pm - Cat 1/2/3 Men / Cat 1/2 Women (1 hr)

Awards: Medals for best OVERALL sprinter (total accumulated points) & OVERALL finisher for the entire series.

Rules: Each race is a combined race for best sprinter and for best finisher. Points will be awarded for top 5 places in designated laps and for top 10 places at the finish. RIDERS OUT OF CONTENTION ON THE LAST LAP WILL BE PULLED. FREE LAP RULE IS IN EFFECT.

Eligibility: You MUST have an ACA license to participate in the races. One-day licenses are available at registration.

Registration: Pre-registration is not allowed, and you only need to register once (except for one day licenses, which must register for each race day). You pay each week when you check in.

Entry Fee: (includes surcharges) \$15 for seniors, \$5 for juniors

Entry scholarships available for juniors unable to pay - please inquire at registration table
