Location, Base Entry & Course Description: Located in Colorado Springs on the Air Force Academy about 65 miles South of Denver on I-25. Please enter through the South Gate, after 6 AM (you can not get to the race through the North Gate), Exit 150, N. Academy Blvd and proceed West to base entrance. A drivers license is required to enter the base (no exceptions, you will be turned away without it) for all occupants in the vehicle. Be prepared for vehicle searches, especially for trailers and trucks. Proceed West on South Gate Blvd and bear right onto Stadium Blvd going North. Continue along Stadium Blvd to Falcon Stadium and follow parking attendant directions. Course is mostly on closed roads, see attached maps for description. 75% of course is closed to traffic with remaining 25% having only one way traffic. 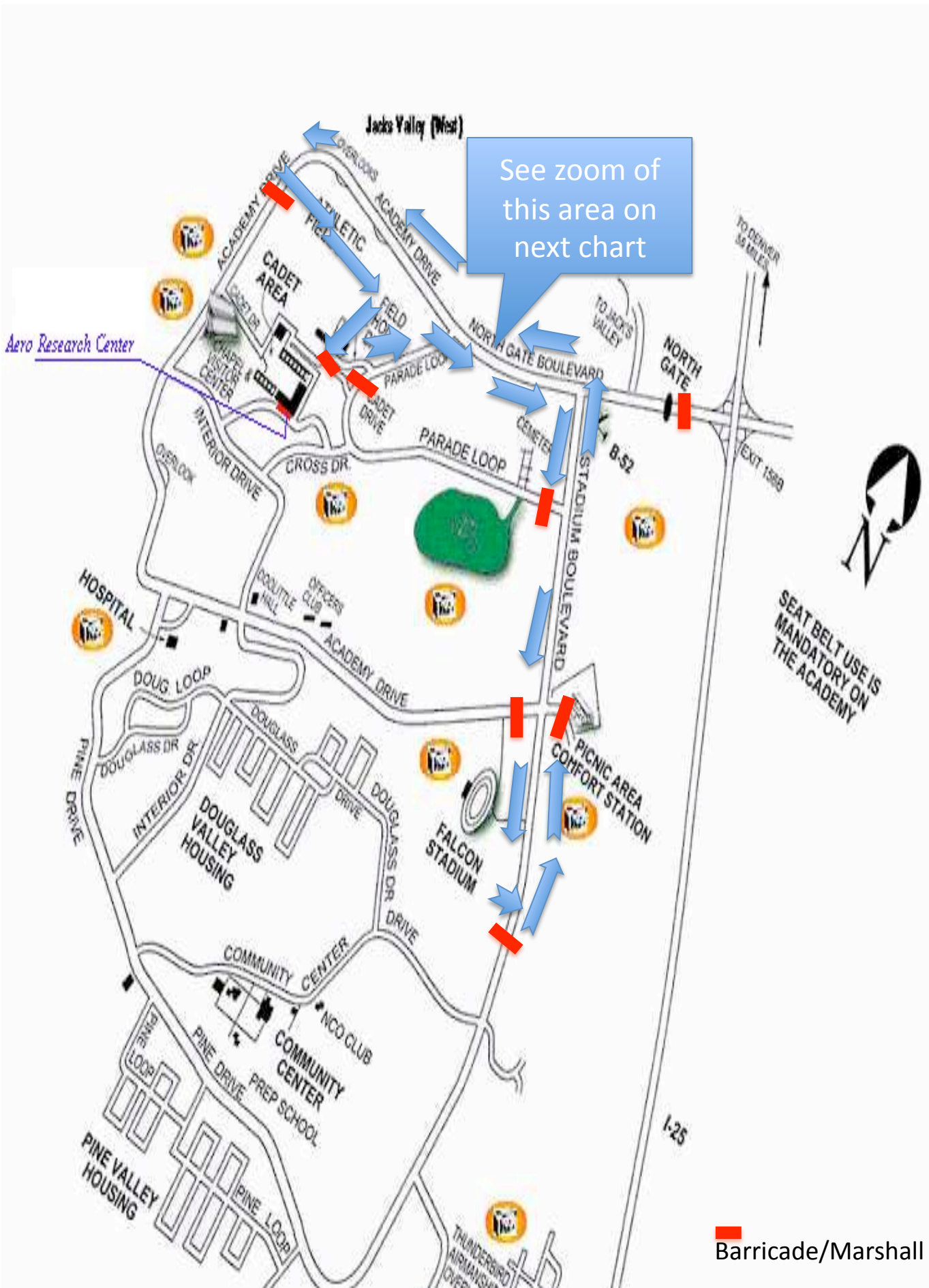

Feedzone/Race Support: Feedzone located near the AFA Field-house—directions at number pick-up. Race support provided by Rol Wheels, Pro Cycling & Ascent Cycling—caravan wheel support may/ may not be provided—be prepared in either case.

Additional Info: Centerline rule will be enforced on North Gate Blvd. On different portions of this road the centerline will be on your left (Eastern/lower portion) or on the right (Western/upper portion)—please use caution during the race. Violators will be DQ'd—no exceptions. No littering—violators will be DQ'd. All ACA rules apply. Event will be run in all conditions unless unsafe for the racers as determined by AFA Security Forces, ACA Officials or Race Promoter. To be eligible for Colorado State Championship medals and/or vest you must hold a current annual ACA license, and must have continuously resided in Colorado for the past six months, see www.americancycling.org/state-championships/awards for info.





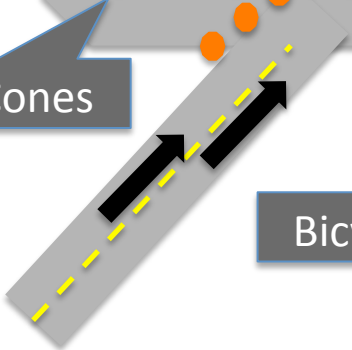
Northgate Blvd

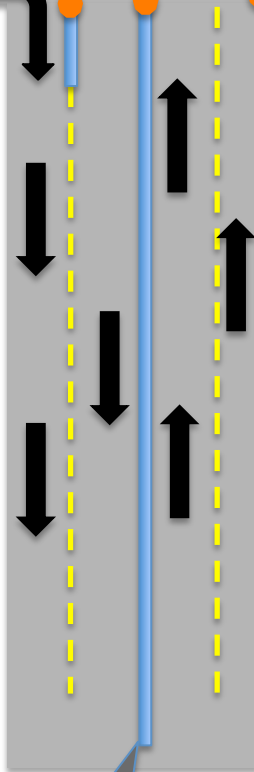
