Where is Hugo?

Hugo, Colorado is located 13 miles southeast of Limon on US-40.

From Denver, follow **I-70 East to Exit 363**, then US-40 south to Hugo.

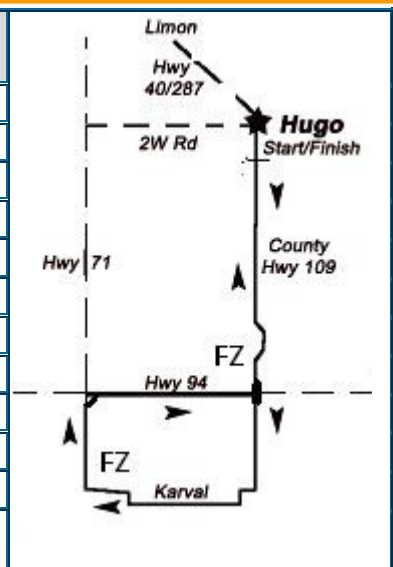
From Colorado Springs, follow US-24 East to I-70 East, I-70 to Exit 363, then US-40 south to Hugo.

This is an easy drive out, which takes less than 2 hours from Denver, Boulder, and Colorado Springs.

With a great course and *a town that supports the race*, this is absolutely worth the drive!
