The course at the Cherry Creek State Park is a rolling- approximately 9.5 miles that is completely open to traffic with an uphill drag to the finish.

The series runs on **Wednesdays, April 7,14,21,28, May 5, 12,and 19.**

The series is **sold as a package of all seven races only.** No individual date entries will be accepted unless the event does not fill to capacity. You must be a **ACA Annual Member in order to participate.** You may purchase a license online by visiting www.americancycling.org.

New in 2010: You must enter through the **EAST GATE** into the park and **pay the \$7/\$8 park entrance** fee this year. You can make your entry quicker by purchasing an annual park pass (approx. \$63). To get to this entrance take I-25 to I-225, I-225 to Parker Road South. Take a right turn into the **EAST GATE**. Racers may not use any other entrance.

The start line is near the Smokey Hill Picnic Area.

Registration Information:

* **Online at RecordRacer.com.** Due to the popularity of the event, registration opens at some point between Noon and 1:00 p.m. March 2nd. You can go to RecordRacer prior to March 2nd to create a login and enter all of your personal information. This DOES NOT register you for the series. You must login after noon on March 2nd, pick an available start time and pay for series in order to be registered. You are not registered until your credit card has been charged AND you receive a confirmation e-mail. There will be NO Team Registration in 2010. No refunds will be given. Your racing number is not transferable to another racer. The entry fee includes an insurance surcharge fee of \$2.39 per rider per day, an Operational Surcharge of \$1.00 per rider per day.

- Individual - \$155.00 for the “7-pack”
- Tandems - \$240 for the “7-pack”
- If riding individually and also on a tandem the fee will be \$280.00
- Juniors racing in the junior category may be part of the Juniors Ride Free Program

STARTS:

Starts will be at 20 second intervals.

- New Start is at the East Shades Restrooms, just downhill from the parking area.
- Don't be late as there is very little time allowance for late starts.
- Tandems will be started in such a way as to not interfere with riders in front or back of them.
- Pick your start time when you register at RecordRacer.com, plan to register early for best selection.
- No juniors, 16 &U, will start after 6:00, due to possible darkness.

NUMBERS

- You will be issued one number for the entire series.
- You must sign a release at number pick up prior to receiving your number.
- Your racing number is nontransferable to anyone else or to any other category.
- Number pick up instructions will be in your confirmation e-mail when you register.

RETRO:

NO TT equipment. Anything more than a shallow section radial laced wheel is TT gear. This includes aero bars, deep section wheels (28mm or deeper), disks, aero helmets, and flat tube frames. Skin suits are allowed. The Chief Referee will make final equipment determination.

AWARDS:

- If there are 15 or more entrants in a category, there will be medals for the top three in that category.

INCLEMENT WEATHER:

- The races will be held rain or shine, sun or snow.
- If weather conditions create a safety hazard, an event may be cancelled by the Chief Referee and the race organizer.
- The cancellation of an event will not result in the race being re-scheduled at a later date as there are no later dates.
- No refunds are given for cancellations due to circumstances out of the organizers control.
- Whether a race is cancelled is usually not determined until after 3:00 of each race date.
- The ACA Race Hotline, **(ACA office number) 303-458-5538**, will leave a recorded message around 3:00 p.m. if an event is cancelled. If no notice of cancellation, the event is on for that evening
- In the event of course problems, the organizer will provide a modified course, around 5 miles in length (as in flooding or construction)

PARKING:

RACERS MUST USE THE EAST ENTRANCE IN 2010!! It is illegal to park on shoulder of road or on grass. If you fail to follow parking marshals instructions you will be ticketed and possibly towed. If in doubt, park outside of the park and ride in. Finishing your race to find that your illegally parked car has been towed is not fun!!

PLEASE NOTE:

All ACA rules apply. STRICT ADHERENCE TO THE CENTER LINE RULE WILL BE ENFORCED. Numbers are not transferable to another person or to another category.
