

Superior Morgul Classic



Friday, May 28th – Sunday, May 30th

Come celebrate the rich history of the legendary Morgul-Bismarck race course, cycling in Colorado and the 25th Anniversary of the cycling movie "American Flyers".

The Superior Morgul Classic includes three days of bike racing, a wellness and sustainability festival including live music and local food the entire weekend. Friday evening begins with **street sprints**, Saturday is a new **criterium** race and Sunday is the legendary Morgul Bismarck **road race**.

The race entry fee includes...

- Entry into all three races with over \$20,000 in cash and prizes
- Individual result placings and weekend omnium results
- Omnium leader jerseys after each stage
- **Free** event T-shirt if registered by May 1
- **Free** admittance to racer food (snack) tent in expo area sponsored by Whole Foods.
- Goodie bag including water bottle and product samples.
- Neutral feed zone in Morgul race.
- **Free** bike valet for expo.
- **Free** expo / concert entries.

Entry Fees:

- Omnium (all three races) = \$110. Before May 1st free T-shirt. Late Fees after May 8th, \$30.
- Sprints only \$25, Criterium only \$40, Road Race only \$60. Late Fees after May 8th, \$10.
- Juniors (<18) race FREE in junior events, only juniors 10 or older may compete.

Fine Print: Race Bible online May 2nd. All ACA Rules apply. ACA Bar/Bat Omnium. Held rain or shine. ACA license required, goto AmericanCycling.org, 1-day license is \$10 per day. Entry fee includes all applicable ACA fees. Chief Referee: Todd Plummer, ACA Permit #: CO-1021, promoting club: Boulder Racing.

Location: Community Park, Superior, CO. Travel Highway 36 north of Denver, exit at the Superior exit, McCaslin Blvd. Head south on McCaslin, make a left on Rock Creek Parkway, continue down the hill to Coalton Drive and follow signs to parking.

Parking: See website for detailed parking plans. Numerous parking areas have been designated and shuttles are available. Please plan accordingly as parking areas may fill up.

Street Sprints – Friday evening, 4:30pm – 8:00pm

The course is a 150- 200m straight roadway where racers start from a standstill and sprint the length of the course to the finish line. Racers will be held up so they can click into pedals before start. Start lists posted the day prior to the race and on site. Four to six racers race at one time, best two racers advance, bracketed format.

The Summit Criterium Saturday all day

A new course centrally located next to the festival. "L" shaped course with a wide start/finish transitioning uphill into narrow alley ways then back to a wide, downhill into the last corner with a slight uphill sprint.

- Wheels in, wheels out.
- Field sizes are limited to 110 per category. Free lap for mishap, except 5 laps to go.

Morgul Bismarck Road Race, Sunday

The infamous road race is back from a 20 year absence. The 13.3 mile loop has 750 vertical feet of elevation gain with significant grades and the finish at the top of the 'Wall'.

- Start will be at Community Park, finish at top of the McCaslin. Course uses McCaslin Blvd, Hwy 128, Hwy 93, Marshall Rd, 76th St, W Coal Creek.
- Centerline rule applies on CO-93 and Marshall Rd
- Riders falling outside of published time cut (TBD) will be pulled and given a pro-rated finish time.
- Neutral feedzone on Hwy 128.
- Limited neutral support provided.

Omnium Competition Individual & Team

Points awarded from each event go towards an omnium and an overall prize list for individuals and teams. Omnium is a points based scoring system.

- **Leader jerseys** awarded after each stage for use in next race. Prizes awarded after Morgul road race.
- Riders do not need to start or finish previous race to race in next race (ie. don't race Street Sprints but can still race Criterium).
- Omnium awards presentation at 6pm on Community Park stage.
