**Event Description:** An Omnium designed for junior racers age 10 to 18. This is an American Cycling Association (ACA) sanctioned event. An ACA license is required to race. An annual ACA junior license can be obtained for \$15 online by visiting [www.americancycling.org](http://www.americancycling.org)

**Registration:** Registration is only available online at [www.signup365.com](http://www.signup365.com) starting April 30<sup>th</sup>. Online Registration cut-off will be Thursday, June 2nd at 11:59am. NO on-site or race-day registration. Make sure to register EARLY!

**Cost:** Cost will be \$50 per rider for the event (total of 3 races). Cost includes all race fee charges and pizza party for racers and families on Saturday night after the criterium. No refunds or cancellations. Race rain or shine.

Silt is located along I-70 in Western Colorado 7 miles west of New Castle and 7 miles east of Rifle. The Silt Holiday Inn Express is the official race hotel. Call 888.465.4329 and make sure to mention "Mini Classic" for a reduced rate.

**Course Descriptions:**

**Time Trial: Saturday AM.** A traditional Out and Back, wide open TT course on the I-70 frontage road. Wind will surely play a role in this event.

**Criterium New course: Saturday PM.** The course winds around Veteran's Park in Silt. A technical, flat "L" shaped course with 6 turns (approx. 0.6 miles). The park offers shade and green space for spectators and families.

**Road Race: Sunday AM.** The marquee stage of the Mini Classic. Start/Finish in Downtown Silt. A 14 mile lap that includes a challenging climb from the start to the "Rollercoaster" descent. The remainder of the course is very challenging due to numerous rolling hills. The exposed nature of this road could mean that the winds will play a significant factor. The lap finishes with a twisting descent back into town.
