## Course Description

Wide open roads in Weld County including State Highway 52. Laps are approximately 23 miles (see attached map), with the exception of JM / JW 10-12, and JW 13-14 who will race an out and back route of 19k on County roads (see attached map).

## Staging Area / Parking

Hoff Elementary School in Keenesburg, just off I-76, 40 miles from Denver and Boulder. It's closer than you think! All we ask is that you please don't drive from Hudson on SH 52 as you will have to drive on part of the course to reach the start line. Please take I-76 from Hudson to Keenesburg... it's an easy drive and this will be a FUN RACE! Show up and lay down some smack!



## The Details

### State Championship Eligibility

Must hold a current Colorado annual USAC and ACA Member, be a USA citizen or permanent resident, and race in a designated championship category (see chart).

### Race Day Registration

Race day registration (add \$5) and number pick-up is at Hoff Elementary in Keenesburg. Registration closes 40 minutes before your category starts. One-day USA Cycling licenses available for \$10, and one-day licensees will race in either the Senior Men Cat 5 or the Senior Women Cat 4 depending upon gender. Cash or check to LMBRC.

### Feed Zone

For all racers going more than 1 lap, the feed zone will be close to the start/finish. This is a Team Feed Zone, not Neutral, so bring a friend to feed you! This is also the ONLY place to discard trash during the race. You litter, you lose. Really.

### Follow Cars

Provided by [www.McDonaldAudi.com](http://www.McDonaldAudi.com). Wheels in, wheels out. While the drivers are not mechanics, and they won't feed you like the TDF, they will schlep your wheels around. While you're Kind Of A Big Deal, there are limits.

### Mechanical Support

The guys from [www.RideNiceBike.com](http://www.RideNiceBike.com) will provide mechanical support at the Start/Finish line. And they will treat you like A Big Deal. Thanks Nice Bike!

### Rules

All ACA rules apply, strict adherence to the CENTER LINE RULE. All riders ride to the right if dropped from group. Helmets must be worn at ALL times.

### Timing Chip / Results

Timing Chip required. No chip, no race. One-day rentals available for \$10 through Madsync, or on race day at registration. Please bring ID, credit card, etc. for collateral. Better yet, bring your own chip on your own bike!

### Awards

Mandatory PODIUM PRESENTATION after the protest period has expired. Awards will be given out for all races with at least 10 entries as per the chart. This is when the world see's just how Big of A Deal you are!

### JUNIOR RESTRICTIONS:

All juniors are gear restricted. "Roll-out method" before the start which limits a top gear to 26' 0" (52-14, 23x700c). Please report 15 minutes prior to start for roll-out. 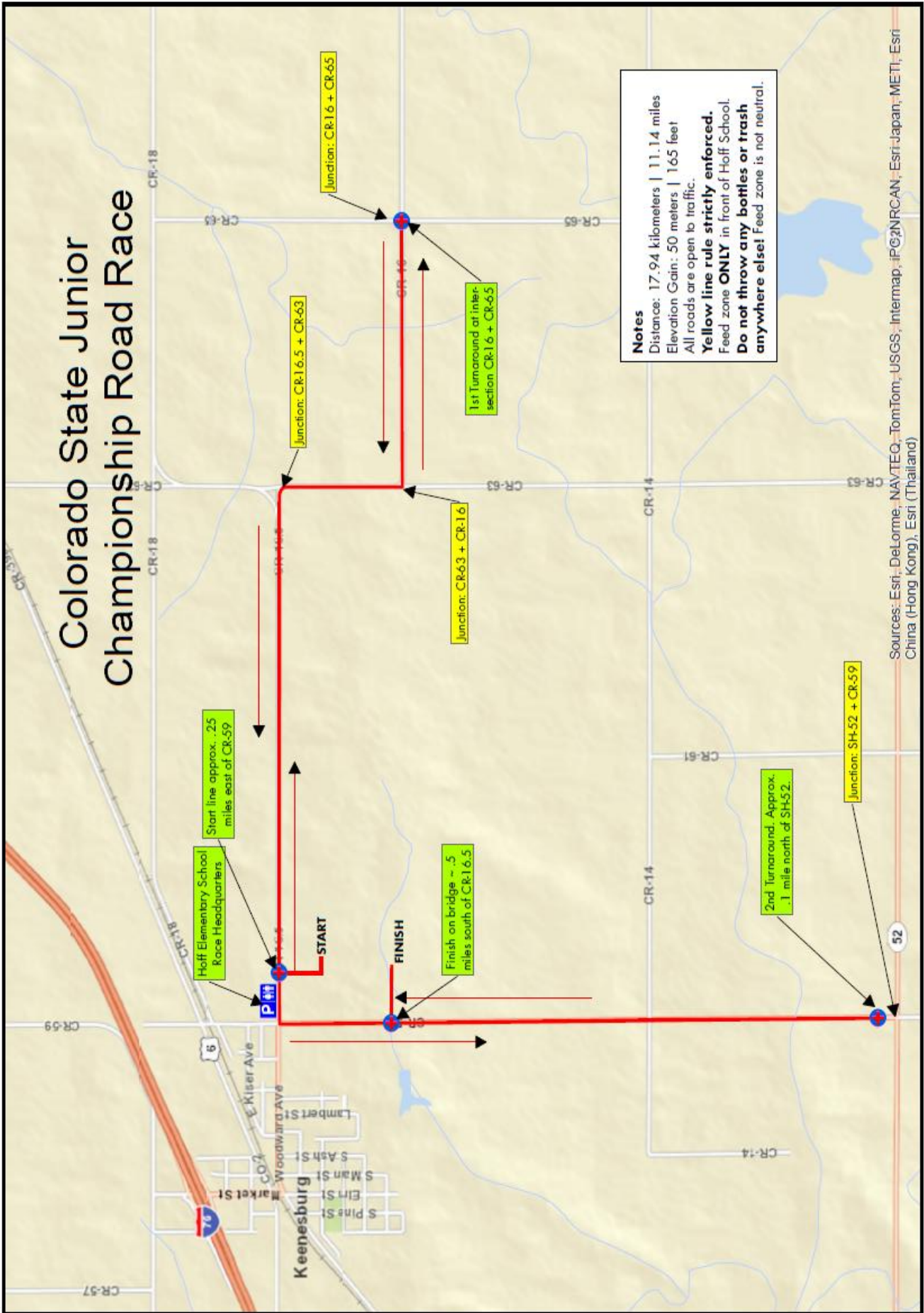
# Keenesburg Detail

1st Turnaround at intersection CR-16 + CR-65

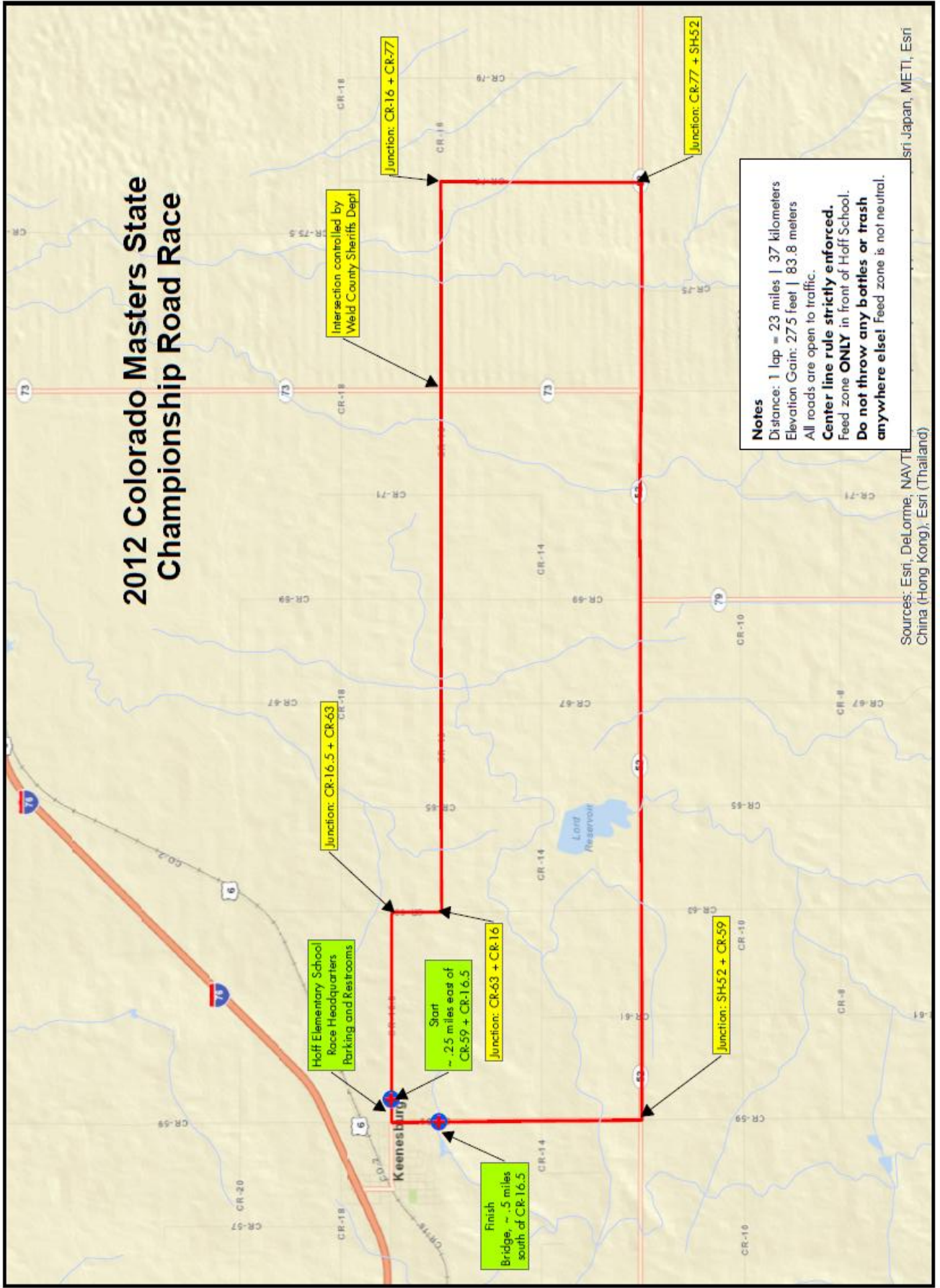
Finish on bridge ~.5 miles south of CR-16.5

2nd Turnaround, Approx. .1 mile north of SH-52.
