THE KICK-IT CROSS FESTIVAL IS A CELEBRATION OF THE COLORADO CYCLO-CROSS COMMUNITY.

The Kick-It Time Trial consists of a single 14-ish minute, point-to-point cross time trial to determine call-up positions for one race: the first big race on the 2012 Cross calendar, which is Boulder Racing #1 at Valmont Bike Park on September 16. After BR# 1, Colorado Cross Cup call-ups will be based on the USA Cycling's Racer Ranking System.

VENUE: The Prairie Center in Brighton, Colorado 80601.

TIMING: ACA D&L Sound Timing System. Racers must have their ACA chip. Rental Chips are \$10. No Chip = No Start. Don't even think about it. Riders without a chip will be DQ'd at the start line.

CHIP CHECK: You must have your chip checked for the cross season. Chip Check located near the start line.

USAC LICENSES (annual or one-day) are required for all categories including Juniors (Pre-J participants must sign standard release form.) All USAC cyclo-cross racing rules and ACA Cross Cup policy will apply. Helmets must be worn during racing or warming up. Race age is determined by your age on 12/31/13. All racers must report to the start line 10 minutes before their start time. Racers can be penalized for interfering with other racers' starts. USAC one-day licenses are available on-site and cost \$10.

THIS EVENT IS PROMOTED BY THE ACA! Those riders who are not ACA members will be assessed a \$5 ACA one-day membership fee. Annual ACA memberships are \$25 and last until the end of the year.

MOUNTAIN BIKES ARE ALLOWED. No bar-ends allowed.

ROL WHEELS MECHANICAL support will be available near the start line.

THERE IS ONE PIT/MECHANICAL ZONE for this event, located approximately at the halfway point of the course. The pit is one way only.

PRE-REG ENTRY FEE: \$15

ACA MEMBERS PREREG DISCOUNT: ACA members who preregister get \$3 discount.

DAY-OF RACE REGISTRATION: Open from 7am until 45 minutes before the last start time. Day of race registration is available for start times after 10:30am.

DAY-OF-RACE ENTRY FEE: \$15

SECOND RACE ENTRY FEE: \$8 (A racer's faster time will be counted).

JUNIORS ENTRY FEE: \$0 (Juniors Ride Free, even in senior categories)

THIS EVENT IS DESIGNED TO BE FUN! BE PREPARED TO STAY BEFORE AND AFTER YOUR RACE TO CELEBRATE ALL THAT IS GOOD ABOUT COLORADO CYCLO-CROSS!

COURSE PREVIEW IS AVAILABLE:

- In the weeks up to the event (thank you **THF Realty** for hosting this event!).
- Early race day until the first rider is racing (All previewing athletes must exit the course by 8:00 am or be DQ'd.). Previewing riders: do not cross the finish line!
- Special Preview Session from 10:00am until 10:30am. All previewing athletes must exit the course by 10:30am or be DQ'd). Previewing riders: do not cross the finish line!
- Watch for the course preview flags.
GREEN = Good To Go, **RED** = Get Off The Course!

FIRST RACER OFF: 8:00 am

INTERVAL BETWEEN RACERS: 30 seconds

STRIDER/SHORT COURSE EVENT FOR THE PRE-JS: Yup. (Biological age 6, 7, & 8) This event will be held at 10am. This event is free, and all participants must sign the standard release form.

PRIZE LIST: Custom trophies for the fastest woman and fastest man on the day. No other prizes will be awarded.

KICK-IT PRIZE DRAWING: Held throughout the day. Must be present to win. Drawing uses Racers' bib numbers. The drawing includes items from Great Divide Brewery, Rudy Project, mix1, Thomson seatposts and stems, Pactimo, 303Cycling kit, and much much more!!!

EXPO SPACE: 1st 10x10 Space is Free. Additional Space: \$50 payable to ACA. Follow directions to the expo. Please note: the Expo is for vendors and industry types. Athletes will be directed to their parking.

ALL EVENT PROCEEDS BENEFIT the ACA Junior Development Program.

RACE HELD RAIN OR SHINE. Race will be cancelled only in event of dangerous weather conditions. The decision to cancel can only be made by the Chief Referee.

ALL RACERS must sign the standard release form.

NO REFUNDS will be given unless event is cancelled.

BIB NUMBERS on Left Side.

TIMING CHIPS on Front of Headtube or Left Ankle Strap (please see www.coloradocycling.org for complete info).

ON-SITE CAMPING is Free.

COURSE DESCRIPTION: The course has it all – speedy sections, rideable hills, barriers, run-ups, stairs, sandy stuff, loose dirt, flyover, and excessive radness. The loop is approximately 14 minutes for the fastest riders.
