The full 2013 Series consists of seven (7) individual time trials on consecutive Wednesday evenings: April 10, 17, 24 and May 1, 8, 15, and 22 at Cherry Creek State Park, 4201 S. Parker Road, Aurora. First racer starts at 4:30 PM, and the final racer at approximately 7:20 PM. The course is approximately 9.6 miles and is totally within the Park.

In addition to the full seven race series individuals can register for just the final four (4) races which are all in May. However, 4-Pack racers will be the last starters and will be at a disadvantage for the overall results for each category, which is your best six races in the series.

USAC rules apply and a USA Cycling license is required, plus a BRAC membership. **Chips (transponders) will not be required.** See www.usacycling.org to purchase an annual license and BRAC membership before registering.

Race Free!!

The full series price includes one free race. The 4-Pack does not, and is \$110 (no junior categories). Individual races, if available on race day, are \$10.00 for juniors and \$27.50 for all others. The series usually sells out. The entry fee includes Madsync, USAC, and BRAC surcharges, but does not include entry to the Park.

Note that USAC 2013 rule 1H4(c) now allows riders to enter one-day time trial events in their category or a higher category at their discretion.

Tandems:

Both tandem riders must have a USAC license, and both must sign releases, although only one needs to apply. The indicated entry fee is for the team and not per individual.

Retro Category:

No time trial equipment allowed. The following equipment is not allowed: aero bars, any rims deeper than 28mm, disk wheels, aero helmets, or flat-tube frames. Skin suits and shoe covers are permitted. The Chief Referee will make final decisions on all retro equipment and clothing.

REGISTRATION:

There are 3 separate registrations on Madsync.com, depending on the criteria below. Be sure you select the correct registration, KHMTT Lottery, KHMTT Late Times, or KHMTT 4-Pack.

KHMTT Lottery: Start times between 4:30 and 6:30 will be based on a lottery similar to last year with riders selecting a preferred slot for their times. Registration will be open until March 15, 2013 on Madsync for the lottery. Juniors and those with a BRAC coupon awarded in 2012 will have preference. KHMTT Late Times: Start times after 6:30 will be based on first come, first served, the same as Bear Creek Lake Park TT Series was in 2012. Be sure that your email address is correct on Madsync. After registering (usually within 48 hours) you will receive an email with available times to select from. **Registration Link:** <http://mad.sc/1ew1>

KHMTT 4-Pack: The 4-Pack registration is also on Madsync. Times will also be on a first come, first served basis, in the order of registration. **Registration Link:** <http://mad.sc/uusg>

All times may be adjusted slightly before number pick-up in order to compress the start times by eliminating empty start times.

NUMBER PICKUP:

Friday, April 5, 3:00 to 6:00 PM at Green Mountain Sports.

Saturday, April 6, 2:00 to 6:00 PM at Adrenalin Cycles (9567 S. University Blvd.

Monday April 8, 3:00 to 6:00 PM at Green Mountain Sports (12364 West Alameda Parkway), and on each race day beginning at 3:00 PM at the Smokey Hill Parking Lot Pavilion.



RULES TO FOLLOW:

All riders must sign a Standard USAC Release; we will print them from Madsync for you.

All USAC rules apply, including STRICT ADHERENCE TO THE CENTER LINE RULE.

All riders must ride to the right unless passing another rider.

Helmets must be worn at all times when on a moving bicycle.

All riders are required to report to the start house 3 minutes prior to their appointed start time per USAC rule 3E5(a).

New Rule Change: Juniors 10-14 must, by USAC rule 1I5, use retro equipment in a time trial.

All juniors are gear restricted by USAC rule 1I4. KHMTT will use the “roll-out method” at the start for all juniors, which limits a top gear to 26’ 0”. Juniors please report a few minutes early to the start to insure that you can be rolled-out in time to make your start time.

Green Mountain Sports will provide mechanical support and can do the gear adjustments in the Smokey Hill Parking Lot.

CHERRY CREEK STATE PARK (CCSP):

We are a guest at CCSP so please act as if your mother is watching you. You must enter the Park through the East Gate. This entrance is located on Parker Road, approximately 1 mile south of the intersection with I-225. Racers may not drive through any other entrance. Single day entrance fee is \$9.00. An annual pass which includes all State Parks is \$73. To purchase an Annual State Park Pass and the \$3 CCWBA pass (required for CCSP) please visit:

Please note: It is illegal to park on the shoulder or on grass in the State Park. Failure to follow instructions from parking marshals will result in tickets and possible towing. You don't want to finish your race and find that your car has been towed.

RACE COURSE AND START INFORMATION:

The 9.6 mile course is held on completely open roads at Cherry Creek State Park and features fast turns, rolling terrain and an uphill drag to the finish. As in 2012, the start line is near the East Shades Restrooms, ¼ mile from the Smoky Hill Picnic Area. Starts are at 20 second intervals - do not miss your start time! Do not warm-up in the area near the boat ramp as the Park does not permit bicycle use of that lot. Tandems will be started in such a way as to not interfere with riders in front or back of them. **Note: The course may be shorten for one or two weeks due to paving operations in the Park.**

WEATHER:

Races will be held in most conditions, including wind, rain, sun, sleet or snow. In the event of flooding or road construction, the event will proceed with a modified course of approximately 4.5 miles. If weather conditions create a safety hazard, an event may be cancelled by the Chief Referee and the race organizer. The cancellation of an event will NOT result in the race being rescheduled. No refunds will be given for any event cancellation.

Race cancellation may not be determined until 3:00 PM on race day. Race cancellation will be posted on the BRAC website: www.coloradocycling.org

PLEASE NOTE:

You will be issued one number for the entire series. Racing numbers are not transferable to another racer. The race number must be pinned correctly on the right side. If the number is obstructed by hair or other obstacles from the view of the spotter or timers then you may not receive a time and any protest is invalid.

RESULTS & AWARDS:

If there are 10 or more entrants in a category, then medals will be awarded to the top three in that category. Please see www.coloradocycling.org for results and other important information. The rider's best placing in six races will be used to determine the overall winner.
