Saturday March 15, 2014 – 8:30AM:

Oredigger Classic Hill Climb – Lookout Mountain - Golden, CO

- Course:** A 4-mile individual time trial to the top of famous Lookout Mountain. This is a challenging climb with 1228ft of elevation, steep grades can be expected!
- Directions:** From Denver drive west on 6th Ave. (HWY 93 through Golden) to 19th St. in Golden. Turn left at 19th St. (Lariat Loop Road). From Boulder take Highway 93 south to Golden and turn right at 19th St. (Lariat Loop Road). From the stoplight the start will be about • mile up the road. Parking is on your left. Please observe NO PARKING areas. *Please show respect for the area residents!*
- Registration:** BRAC categories must pre-register online at www.prerace.com. No day of race registration. Online registration closes Thursday (3/13) at 10pm. Pre-registration for BRAC categories is limited to the first 400 racers. BRAC racers may choose to register in their proper category or register in a higher category, but not a lower category. **Collegiate categories register on race day.** Collegiate registration opens at 10am and closes at 12:30pm.
- Entry Fees:** Entry Fee for BRAC categories are \$25, \$10 for Juniors (annual BRAC Juniors race **FREE**), \$20 for Collegiate. Collegiate riders will have a \$1 per rider surcharge for results and points services. Entry fees include USAC insurance surcharges and local association fees. Second race entry fee is \$10. No refunds. BRAC Juniors will be reimbursed on race day.
- Licenses:** Collegiate categories require collegiate license. USAC license required for all USAC categories. All licenses can be purchased at www.usacycling.org. Collegiate 1-Days and USAC 1-Day available at race site for \$15.00. (USAC 1-days only available to Cat 5 men and Cat 4 women who did not previously hold a USAC license with a higher category) BRAC annual membership recommended at USAC races to avoid \$5.00 1-Day BRAC membership. (BRAC 1-D membership fee waived w/USAC 1-Day license).BRAC memberships can be purchased at www.coloradocycling.org.
- Start Times:** The first BRAC rider will start at 8:30. First Collegiate rider will start at 12pm. The start list for pre-registered riders will be posted at <http://recsports.mines.edu/REC-Club-Sports-Cycling> on Friday morning as well as at the start on Saturday. Pick up race numbers and sign USAC waiver at least 30 min prior to start time.

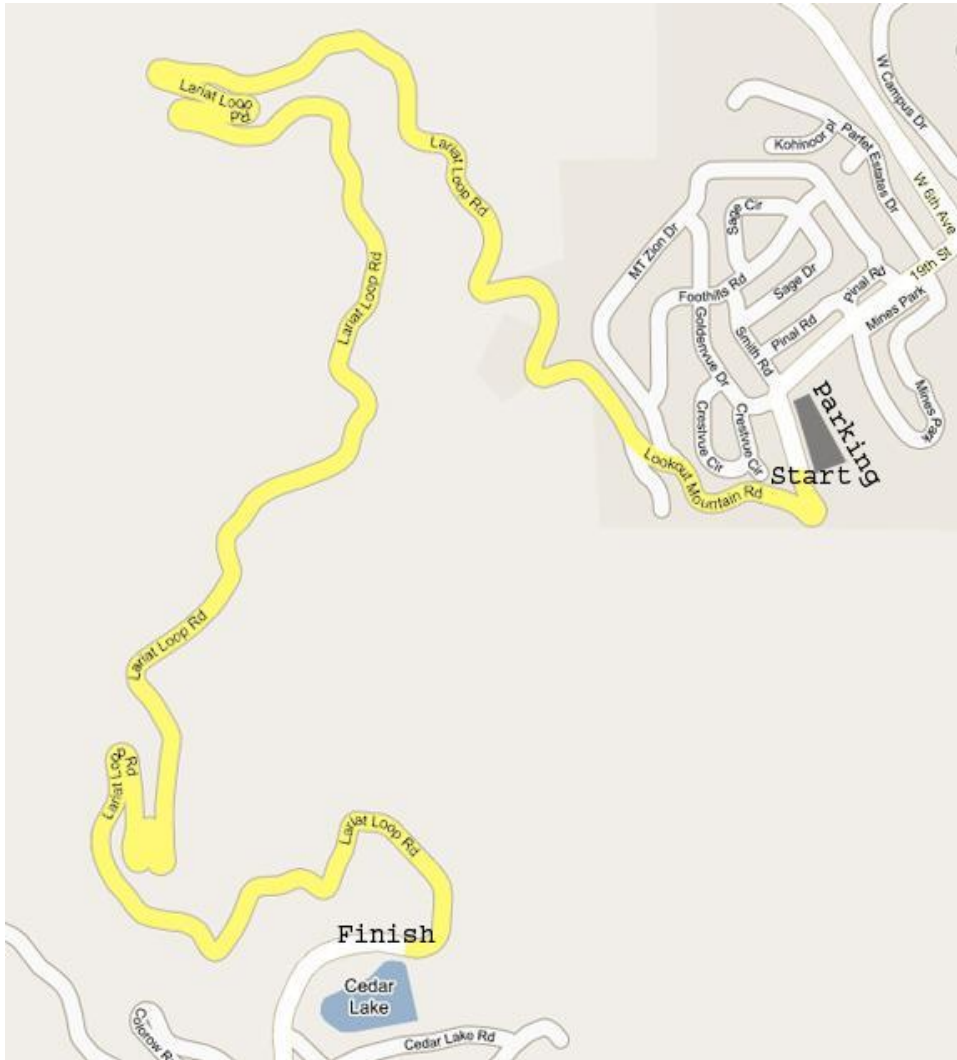
