#2 Whilst traveling east (away from the mountains) on Arapahoe rd, turn left on 63rd St.


#### **Parking:**

Non-Collegiate Races: Must have valid USAC license and BRAC license\*

\*BRAC annual membership recommended to avoid BRAC 1-Day membership (\$5) on race day.

USAC 1-Day *Beginner* license: \$15, only for Cat 5 men,Cat 4 Women and Juniors who have never previously held a USAC license with a higher category. Can **only** be purchased online
