Race: This classic circuit race will challenge your skills and mental toughness.

Entry Fees: USAC license is required. All pre-registered racers pay \$35. *Day of race is \$40.*

Entry fees include operation & insurance surcharges. Riders must present their 2014 USAC license with BRAC membership sticker or pay a 1-Day BRAC Membership fee (\$5). (1-day USAC license exempt). Fee for second race is \$10. Cat 5 is the citizens race. USAC 1-Day

Beginner license: \$15, only for Cat 5 men,, Cat 4 Women and Juniors who have never previously held a USAC license with a higher category. Can **only** be purchased online at [www.usacycling.org/events/?state=CO](http://www.usacycling.org/events/?state=CO), select appropriate event, then click on Purchase One-Day License. Gear restrictions will be enforced for all juniors entering senior events. USAC Release waiver must be signed by all racers or parents/legal guardian for anyone 18 years or younger. Racers
