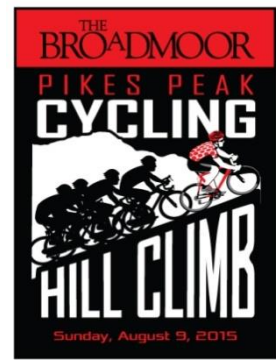

REGISTRATION: ALL CYCLISTS MUST PRE-REGISTER FOR THIS EVENT! NO DAY OF REGISTRATION.

Early Registration begins March 13th and closes April 30th. Early Registration Fee is **\$55** (\$20 for Juniors- U19).

Standard Registration begins May 1st and closes August 5th. Standard Registration Fee is **\$60** (\$25 for Juniors – U19)

Packet Pickup Registration will be held at all packet pickup locations. Packet Pickup Registration Fee is **\$70** (\$35 for Juniors – U19).

RACE INFO:

All USAC Rules apply. USAC waiver must be signed by all racers or parent/guardian for anyone 18 years or younger. USAC license required. USAC **Beginner** 1-Day license: \$15 only available to Cat 5 Men, Cat 4 Women, Jrs, who have never previously held a USAC license with a higher category. Can be purchased when registering online. USA Cycling annual Licenses available online at www.usacycling.org. Annual USAC license holders without BRAC annual membership must buy one day BRAC license \$5. Hand cyclists will need USAC annual or USAC **Beginner** 1-Day license.

GEAR RESTRICTIONS apply to all junior racers - See USAC Rule 114.

CHIP TIMING WILL BE IN USE. More info regarding chip timing will be sent to all registrants.

DIRECTIONS: Take I-25 to Downtown Colorado Springs. Exit I-25 at exit 141, to Highway 24 West. Follow Highway 24 West to Cascade, Colorado, approximately 10 miles. Turn left at the Cascade traffic signal and follow the signs to the Pikes Peak Highway.

PARKING: Parking will be at multiple locations near the Start Line and down to Crystal Reservoir Visitors Area. Check the map on the event website for parking locations.

GATEWAY FEE: All cyclists will receive a pass to access the highway in their race packet. Everyone accessing the Pikes Peak Highway Gateway the day of the race must either have a pass or they will be charged the normal Pikes Peak Highway fee. This fee must be paid by race support members and/or family members. Fees are;

Ages 6-15 = \$5 per person

Ages 16 and older = \$12 per person

Family Plan (up to 5 people) = \$40

COURSE: This is the same course that The Broadmoor Pikes Peak International Hill climb has been using for auto racing since 1916. Cyclists will negotiate over 154 turns, for 12.5 mi/20 km, and climb over 4,700 feet to reach the summit.

START: The start line is located approximately 6 miles uphill from the Pikes Peak Highway Gateway, just past Crystal Reservoir. The start time for the first wave of Competitive Hill Climb cyclists will begin at approximately 6:15 am.

CLOTHING DROP OFF: We will transport your warm clothing bag to Summit. Bags must be in start area 20 min prior to the start and **MUST** be tagged with your corresponding race number.

REST AREAS: There will be snack & hydration stations at the Festival and Awards Area, Halfway Picnic Grounds, Ski Area, Glen Cove, Double Cut and at the Summit. Please bring a water bottle and remember **NOT** to litter! We ask you to be considerate of others.

TECHNICAL SUPPORT: There will be a mechanic with "limited" support at all Rest Areas, and a SAG vehicle following the Competitive Hill Climb cyclists. Check the online course map for specific locations.

BRAKE CHECK: MANDATORY brake checks will be conducted at the Glen Cove gate by Pikes Peak Highway staff for all cyclists descending from the Summit and continuing down to the highway.

WEATHER: The Race and Ride will be held rain or shine, no refunds. The Race Director and Pikes Peak Highway staff have the authority to shut down the ride due to weather or other concerns.

TIME LIMIT: Cyclists must finish by 9:15 am to be officially timed and placed. At that time, timing will end for the competitive races and rides. Pikes Peak Highway will be open to vehicle traffic at Crystal Reservoir at 9:00 am. Cyclists who have not finished as of 9:15 am may continue to ride until they encounter the escort vehicle descending from the Summit. This vehicle will be specially marked and will lead cyclists from the Summit to the Festival and Awards Area. Cyclists that encounter the escort vehicle descending from the Summit are required to abort their ride and join this procession. This is MANDATORY as per the use agreement with the Pikes Peak Highway and due to safety concerns with uphill vehicle traffic after 9:00 am.

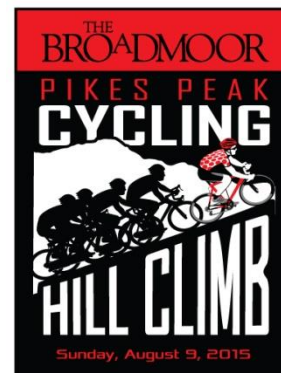

REGISTRATION: ALL CYCLISTS MUST PRE-REGISTER FOR THIS EVENT! NO DAY OF REGISTRATION.

Early Registration begins March 13th and closes April 30th.

Early Registration Fee is Start to Halfway Picnic Grounds \$15, Start to Glen Cove \$30, Start to Summit \$50,

Team Relay (3/team) \$60/team

Standard Registration begins May 1st and closes August 5th.

Standard Registration Fee is Halfway \$20, Glen Cove \$35, Summit \$55, Team Relay \$70

Packet Pickup Registration will be, Halfway \$30, Glen Cove \$45, Summit \$65, Team Relay \$95

FUN RIDE INFO: NO ELECTRIC ASSIST ALLOWED! Recumbent, elliptical, unicycle, tandems, and hand cycles are allowed. USAC Release waiver must be signed by all riders or parent/guardian for anyone 18 years or younger. No license is required.

There will be four options for Gran Fondo rides:

Team Relay – 3 cyclists per team, each riding a separate leg (listed below); teams can be mixed gender

Halfway Picnic Ground Gran Fondo – 2.4mi/4km – 570 ft elevation gain from start line

Glen Cove Gran Fondo – 6mi/9km – 2,050 ft elevation change from start line

Summit Gran Fondo – 12.5mi/20km – 4,720 ft elevation change from start line

DIRECTIONS: Take I-25 to Downtown Colorado Springs. Exit I-25 at exit 141, to Highway 24 West. Follow Highway 24 West to Cascade, Colorado, approximately 10 miles. Turn left at the Cascade traffic signal and follow the signs to the Pikes Peak Highway.

PARKING: Parking will be at multiple locations but near the Start Line and down to Crystal Reservoir Visitor Area. Relay teams will be permitted to park a transport vehicle at Glen Cove. Check the event website for more parking information.

Everyone accessing the Pikes Peak Highway Gateway the day of the race must either have a pass or they will be charged the normal Pikes Peak Highway fee. This fee must be paid by race support members and/or family members. Fees are;

AWARDS: Medals will be awarded to the top three finishers in men's, women's and Juniors (U19) who participate in the Gran Fondo Halfway Picnic Grounds, Grand Fondo Glen Cove, and Gran Fondo Summit, as well as the top three Relay Team finishers.
