**Championship Medals and Jerseys**

Only current USAC annual licensees who are USA citizens or permanent residents and reside in the local association area known as BRAC as shown on their license are eligible to compete for the State (BRAC) Championship Title. Additionally, to receive the Champion jersey you must be a current annual member of BRAC. Professional men and women are welcome to race, but are not eligible for State (BRAC) Championship title, medal or jersey.

**USAC License Required:**

USAC 1-Day Beginner license: \$15, only for Cat 5 men, Cat 4 Women and Juniors who have never previously held a USAC license with a higher category. 1-Day license can be purchased day of race or at [www.usacycling.org/events/?state=CO](http://www.usacycling.org/events/?state=CO). Select appropriate event, then click on Purchase One-Day License. Bring receipt to race. Annual licenses available online at [usacycling.org](http://usacycling.org)

**BRAC annual membership** required to avoid \$5 onsite fee. BRAC 1-day membership \$5, available on site (BRAC 1-day membership exempt with USAC 1-day). Annual memberships available at [coloradocycling.org](http://coloradocycling.org). BRAC annual membership is required for points obtained to count towards Rocky Mountain Road Cup individual or team competitions.

### From Boulder

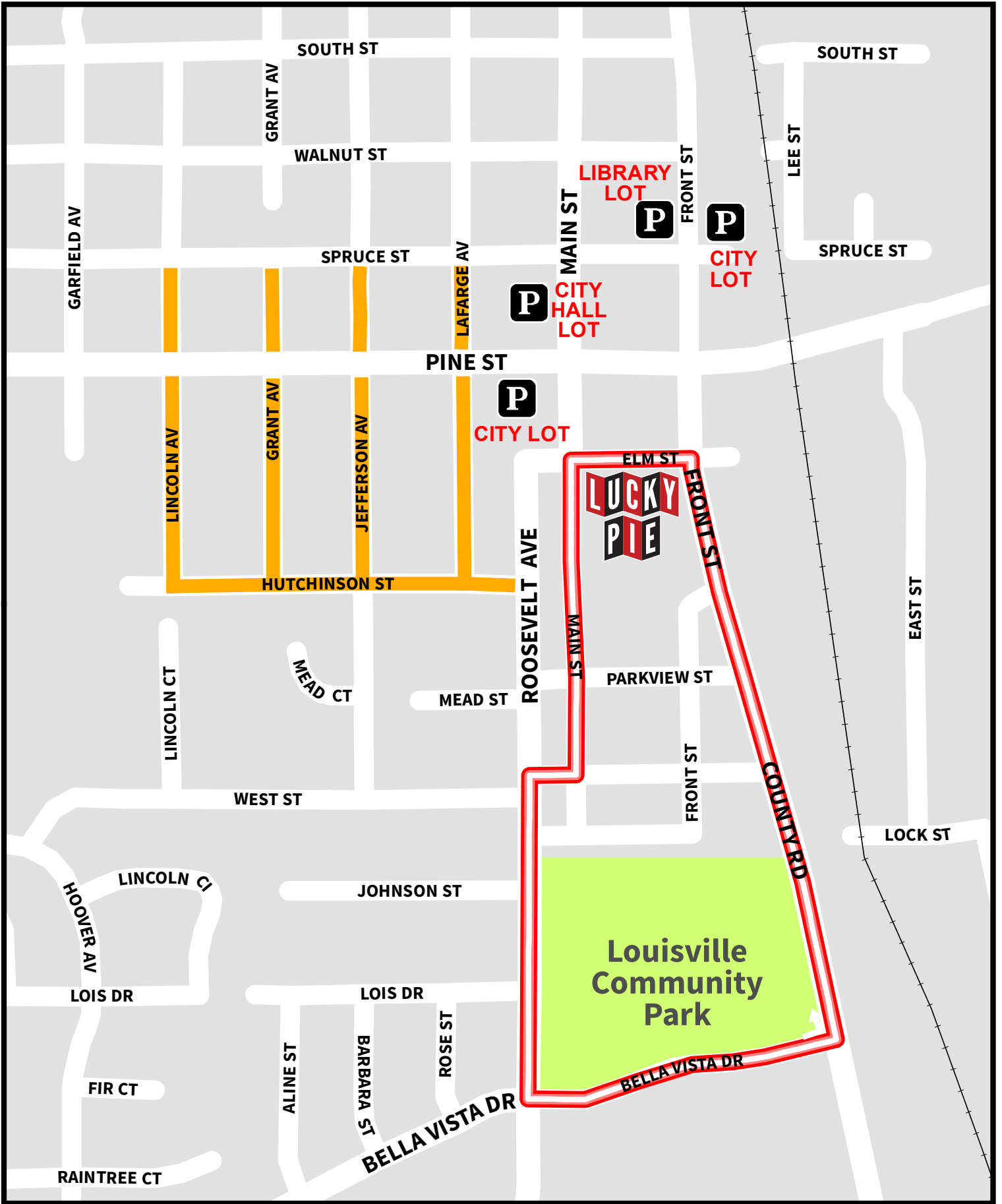
South Boulder Road east, right on 96th, right on Pine Street.

### From Denver

Hwy 36, right off StorageTek Drive exit, left on 96th, left on Pine Street.

**The Lucky Pie Criterium**, brought to you by Lucky Pie and Sonic Boom Racing, is Louisville's most exciting spectator race and is coming back to Downtown Louisville this summer with an all new race course. Come watch as Colorado's best cyclists race around Community Park. The race course will start on Front Street for a roll out on to Elm Street. The course follows a counter-clockwise path down Main & Roosevelt turning left on Bella Vista and around Louisville's largest public park. The streets are wide and smooth, and the course is flat and fast. The finish is a long straight-away down County Road for a championship-style sprint finish.

**The Sweet Cow Kids Race** is free and open to all kids 8 and under. All kid participants receive a free ice cream cone sponsored by Sweet Cow.
