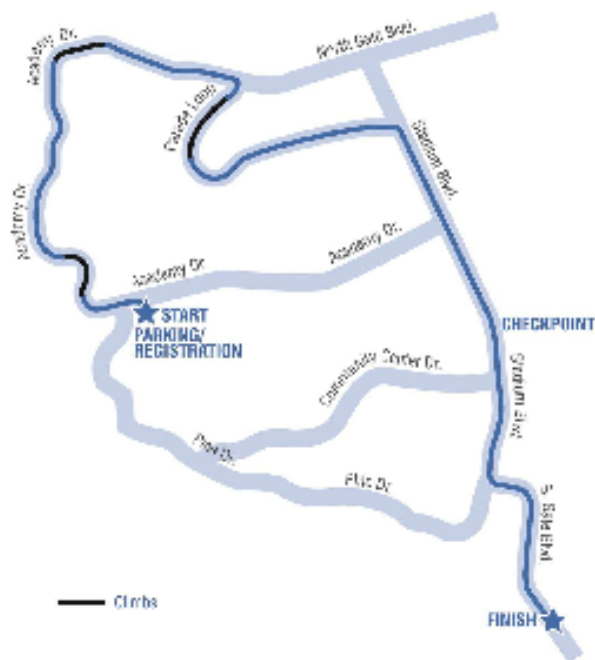

Example. Pro/1/2 road race will pay out \$600, 9 deep as shown above as long as the field size is at least 26 riders. If the race only has 17 riders, it will pay out \$300, 5 deep.

CAUTIONS

- TTT and road courses are open to traffic; during TTT, stay on shoulder whenever possible; during road race, you are in rolling enclosure; if off the back, obey the rules of the road
- High winds are common at USAFA; use deep dish wheels at your own risk
- *Crossing the centerline results in DQ*

SUPPORT

- Trash receptacles and portable toilets provided
- Water availability is dependent on weather; plan to bring your own fluids
- No team vehicles allowed on courses
- Neutral support may be available for some categories



REGISTRATION & DIRECTIONS

COLLEGIATE RIDERS

Register day of race with school
Must have USAC license

NON-COLLEGIATE RIDERS

Pre-register by 1 Apr at: <http://www.usacycling.org/>
(up to \$3.30 service charge)

\$10 late fee for day-of registration

Must have USAC license & BRAC membership; one-day license/membership (\$15) available on-site for Cat 5 men & Cat 4 women who were not previously a higher category (BRAC included); 1-day BRAC membership (\$5) also available

Cash only on day-of registration
(Schools with single check allowed)

Held rain or shine. If cancelled, partial refund may exist after accounting for race expenses.

DIRECTIONS

All events start at the base hospital. Take I-25 Exit 156 (North Gate) and head west to enter USAFA. Take the first left onto Stadium Blvd (at the B-52). Turn right on Academy Dr (just before football stadium). The hospital will be on the left after the fire station. Marshals will direct you to parking. NOTE: You will be driving in the westbound lane next to the crit course (in eastbound lane) so please use caution.

BASE ACCESS

- Must enter through North Gate
- Government-issued photo ID required
- No entry prior to 8am without pre-registration
- Early access starting at 5:30am for pre-registered riders that provide full name, date of birth, and driver's license number & state of issue
