Race Course: Race the Hill the pros will climb in the USA Pro Cycling Challenge, 1228 feet of climbing in 4.5 miles. This will be a mass start event beginning at the "pillars". Climb finishes at the "post" just prior to the turn off for Buffalo Bill's grave.

Directions: The race start is in Golden, CO at the base of Lookout Mountain. From Denver drive west on 6th Ave. (this is Highway 93 through Golden) to 19th St. in Golden. Turn left at 19th St. (Lariat Loop Road). From Boulder take Highway 93 South to Golden and turn right at 19th St. (Lariat Loop Road). Parking will be on Lariat Loop road and side streets. Please observe NO PARKING areas. Golden Police will ticket you.

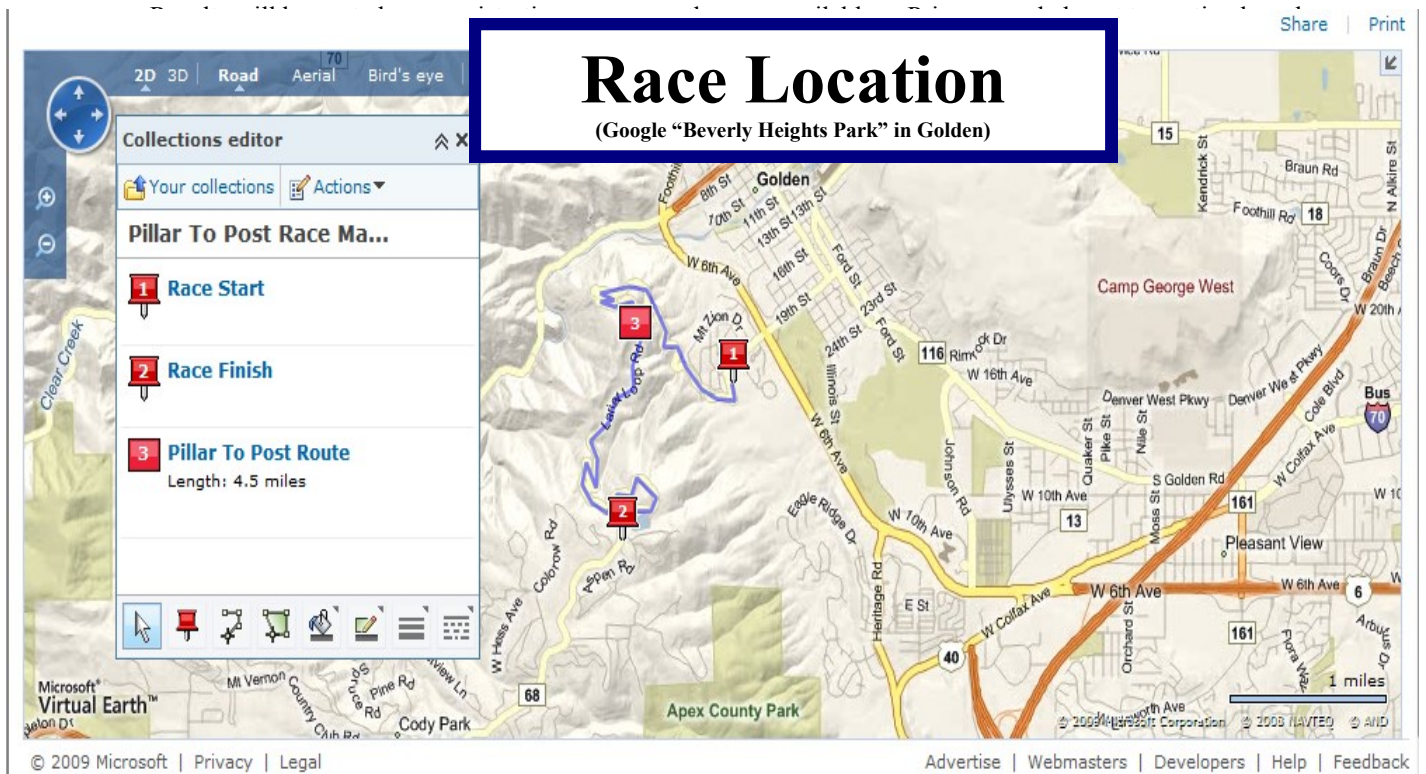
NO PARENTS ON THE COURSE DURING JUNIOR RACES

Entry Fees: USA Cycling license is required. All **pre-registered** senior racers will pay **\$40**. Entry fees include operations & insurance surcharges. All racers 18 and under are free for **junior categories only**. Racers must present their 2015 USAC BRAC Licenses at number pickup. One-day USAC licenses can only be purchased online at www.usacycling.org/events/?state=CO, select appropriate event, and then click on Purchase One-Day License, proof of purchase required to receive bib on race day.

To be eligible for the Jr 9-16 Championships, all participants must hold a current USAC annual license who are USA citizens or permanent residents and reside in the local association area known as BRAC as shown on their license are eligible to compete for the State (BRAC) Championship Title. Additionally, to receive the Champion jersey you must be a current annual member of BRAC. Professional men and women are welcome to race, but are not eligible for State (BRAC) Championship title, medal or jersey.

Annual licenses available online at www.usacycling.org. USAC Release waiver must be signed by all racers or parent/guardian for anyone 18 years and younger.

Refund of entry fees only if race is postponed and not rescheduled in 2015.
