**Where:** Lookout Mtn. Youth Services Center. 2901 Ford Street, Golden, Colorado. Just South of the roundabout at Johnson Rd. and South Golden Rd.

**To get to the race course:** As you enter the main drive for the facility, you'll see a dirt road on the left immediately before the entrance gate. Follow the dirt road to race parking. There is **NO PARKING** on the asphalt. Please honor this so we can keep using this facility.

**All riders must present a USAC annual license. USAC 1-Day Beginner licenses WILL NOT be sold at the race site USAC 1-Day Beginner license: \$15, only for Cat 5 Men, Cat 4 Women and Juniors who have never previously held a USAC license with a higher category. Make sure to bring your USAC license with BRAC sticker attached!**

**Cancellation Policy.** This is cyclocross. We will race: rain, snow, wind, sun, mud. **UNLESS THE DECISION IS MADE THAT THE WEATHER CONDITIONS WILL RESULT IN PERMANENT DAMAGE TO THE VENUE**

**Rules:** Call ups will be based on points accumulated during the series. For race #1 call ups will be by number sequence determined at registration.
