



Licenses:
Collegiate Riders –
Must have collegiate license.

Non-Collegiate Riders –
USAC One-Day Beginner license: \$15 (Only for Cat. 5 men, Cat 4. women and Juniors who have never previously held a USAC license with a higher category.) Only available at **USA Cycling.com**. Bring receipt to race. Annual licenses available online at **USA Cycling.org**.

BRAC annual membership recommended to avoid BRAC one-day membership (\$5) on race day. (BRAC One-Day Membership exempt with USAC One-Day). Annual Memberships available online at **coloradocycling.org**.

Registration:
Organizers reserve the right to combine categories based on registration numbers.

Online registration can be found at **USA Cycling.com**. Online registration fees increase April 1, 2015. Registration closes April 22, 2015. Field size limited to 100 per category. Day-of registration closes one hour before start.

Scoring:
Omnium scoring must race three out of four events to be eligible. Women's groups and Men's Masters scored separately.

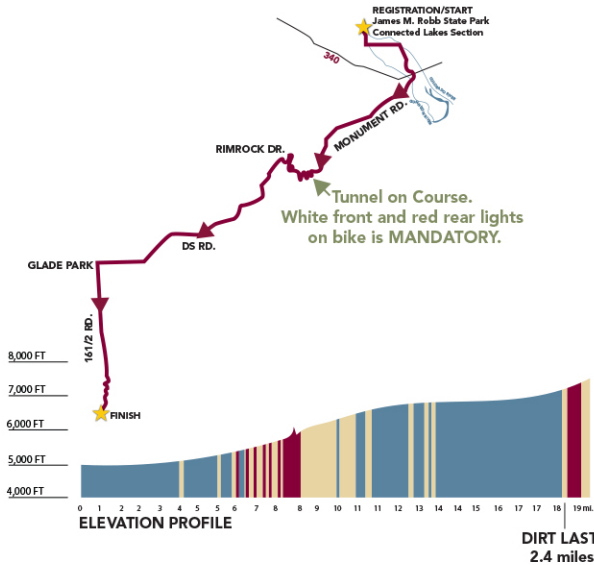

Cross the river to the light at Dike Road. Turn right on Dike Rd. and proceed 1.2 miles into James M. Robb State Park's Connected Lakes section.

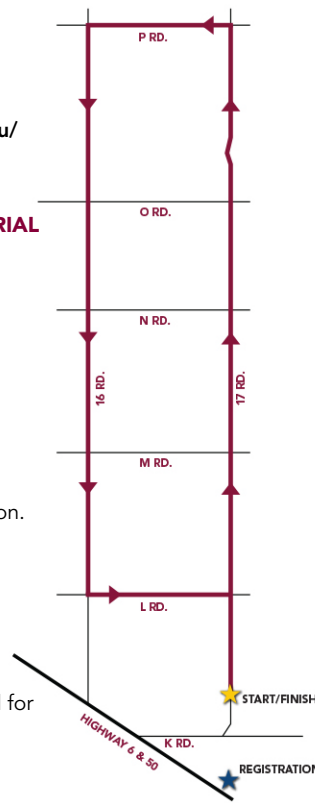

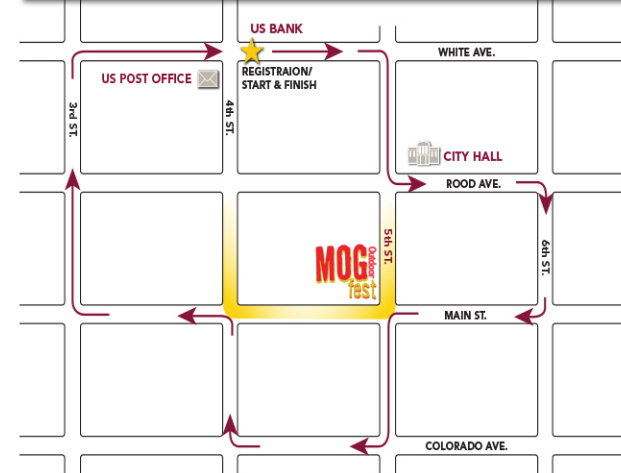
DIRECTIONS TO ROUTE

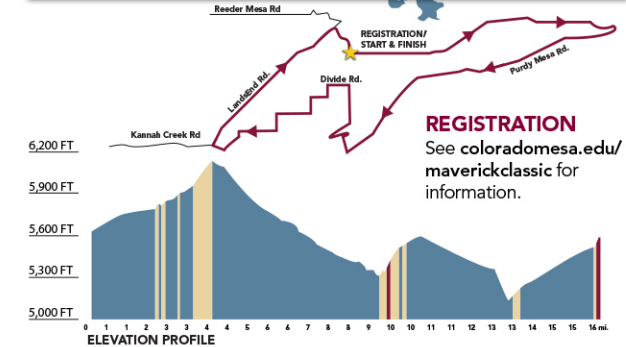

This is a 17-mile rural winding course at the base of the scenic Grand Mesa with significant elevation gains and losses.

CAUTIONS

- Course open to traffic, rolling enclosure during race; off the back obey rules of the road.

DIRECTIONS TO ROUTE

Take I-70 eastbound to exit 37 toward CO 141/32 Road. Exit onto I-70W toward Clifton. Continue 1.1 miles and turn left on CO 141/32 Road. Continue on CO 141/32 Road. until it turns into Highway 50. Turn left on CO 141/US 50 toward Delta/Montrose. Proceed 6.9 miles and turn left onto Kannah Creek Road. Go 3 miles on Kannah Creek Road. and left on to Lands End Road. Proceed 2.6 miles down Lands End Road. and turn right onto Divide Road. Start/finish is at the top of the hill.
