No race day registration for USAC Hill Climb TT categories. Collegiate Hill Climb TT and Street Sprints registration opens 10:00 AM on 3/14, closes 12:30 PM. Criterium registration opens 7:00 AM 3/15, closes 45 minutes before race. Registration can be found online at www.usacycling.org. Online registration closes midnight on Wednesday March 11, 2015.

Lookout Mountain Hill Climb TT Saturday March 14

Directions: From Denver take 6th Ave. west to 19th St. in Golden and turn left. From Boulder take Highway 93 to 19th St. and turn right. Continue on 19th St. for one mile to the start. Parking is to the left of the start. Please show respect for area residents and observe NO PARKING areas.

Course: A four mile individual time trial on the legendary Lookout Mountain. Start at the pillars and finish at Buffalo Bill's Grave.

Entry Fees: \$30 for open riders. \$15 for juniors. Juniors racing in junior events will be reimbursed on race day. Second race entry fees are \$15. There will be no refunds.

Oredigger Street Sprints Saturday March 14

This is a collegiate only event.

Directions: From Denver take 6th Ave. west to 19th St. in Golden and turn right. From Boulder take Highway 93 to 19th St. and turn left. Take left at first light onto Illinois St. then right onto 18th St. Parking will be on the left. Race start is at the intersection of 12th St. and Illinois St.

Course: A straight, 400 meter sprint with a steep hill. Racers will compete four at a time with the winner advancing in a bracket style event.

Start Times: Races will begin at 4:30 PM with Women's C. Start times will vary based on the number of competitors.

Oredigger Classic Criterium Sunday March 15

Directions: From Denver take 6th Ave. west to 19th St. in Golden and turn right. From Boulder take Highway 93 to 19th St. and turn left. Take left at first light onto Illinois St. then right onto 18th St. Parking will be on the left. Start/Finish is on Elm St. on the west side of the Mines campus.

Course: A fast, flat, 1.1 km course along the School of Mines Greek row and intramural fields.

Entry Fees: \$35 for open riders. \$15 for juniors. Juniors registering online will be reimbursed on race day. Second race entry fees are \$15. There will be no refunds.

Collegiate Events:

Riders must have a USAC collegiate license.

Non-Collegiate Events:

USAC license required for all USAC categories. All licenses can be purchased at www.usacycling.org. 1-day licenses available at race site for \$15.00. (USAC 1-days only available to Cat 5 men and Cat 4 women who did not previously hold a USAC license with a higher category).

BRAC annual membership recommended at USAC races to avoid \$5.00 1-day BRAC membership. (BRAC 1-day membership fee waived w/USAC 1-Day license). BRAC memberships can be purchased at www.coloradocycling.org.

The Lookout Mountain Hill Climb TT is a BRAC bronze cup event. The Oredigger Classic Criterium and Street Sprints are not.
