Montrose, CO: North on US-50 to I-70 West and follow Denver directions above...

Utah Border: I-70 East to Exit 19, left off exit onto Cherry St and follow Denver directions above, starting at Cherry St.

PRE-REG BIB # pickup: You must pick up your race # at least 40 min prior to your race start. If you purchased the 5 pack, you must pick up a new race # every time as your number will change.

ALL REGISTRATION PRICES (both sports):

- Adults: \$30 (pre-reg) / \$35 (race day)
- College Students: \$5 discount - show ID
- Pre J (8&U): Free (pre-reg) / Free (race day)
- Jr's 9-18: \$10 (pre-reg) / \$15 (race day)
- Jr's in category: \$25 (pre) / \$30 (race day)
- Race Day Registration Opens at 7:30am & **closes 40 min prior to race start!!!**
- **2nd race is \$15 (any sport).**

Field Limit Size: 125 per wave

Course Preview: Use BYPASS when previewing. Green/Red Flag system in use. Course preview only when Green Flag is flying.

Refunds & Transfers: See Refund/Transfer Policy on www.madracingcolorado.com for details.

Starts - Runners & PreJ @ lap/finish line area. Cyclists @ assigned start locations (TBA onsite).

Call-Ups: Based on USAC Rankings system. Report 10 min prior to start.

OTHER: DO NOT cross the Finish Line after your race ends and please clear the finish area immediately for safety and out of courtesy.

WEATHER: Held rain/snow/shine, race updates posted on Mountain And Desert Racing Facebook & Twitter accounts.

CHIP TIMING: All riders must p/u & wear a timing chip, handed out race day. If you drop out of the race, you must report to us and toss the disposable chip in the trash. You will be given a new one for each race. Chips will be worn on your helmet. NO CHIP = Relegation to last place. Camera backup only for determining mass sprint finish & will not be used to determine placing of riders w/o chips.

Race Rules: All USAC & USATF Rules Apply - CYCLING / USAC -

USAC License Required: USAC 1-Day Beginner license: \$10, only for Cat 5 men, Cat 4 women, and Jrs who have never held a USAC. Can only be purchased online at www.usacycling.org/events/?state=CO

select appropriate event, then click on Purchase One-Day License. Bring receipt to race. Annual licenses available online at: www.usacycling.org.

BRAC annual membership recommended to avoid \$5 onsite fee. BRAC 1-day membership \$5, available onsite (BRAC 1-day membership exempt with USAC 1-day or out of state USAC license holder. Annual memberships available online at www.coloradocycling.org.

BRAC annual membership is required to obtain points for CO Cross Cup competitions. If racing without BRAC license, no points will be reported.

USAC Waiver - must be signed by all racers or parent/guardian for anyone 18&U.

- RUNNING / USATF -

USAC Waiver - must be signed by all racers or parent/guardian for anyone 18&U. (BRAC/USAC license is NOT required to run!)

- Urban Tread Adventures (UTA) Series -
No licenses required for UTA Series Points Overall for both sports. Best of 4 out of 5 will be awarded.
