Wednesday Evening Race Series: June 1,8,15,22; July 6,13, 20,27; Aug 3,10,17,24

Category Pro-1-2-3's begin at 6:00 pm ~ 14 laps

Category 4-5's begin at 7:10 pm ~ 10 laps

Location: Colorado State Patrol Training Facility, Golden, Colorado. From South Golden Road turn north on Quaker Street through open green gates where pavement ends & dirt begins. Follow this dirt road up hill to top of Table Mountain where pavement resumes. Parking is allowed on this road & up to 100 foot before the race track.

Track Access not available until after ALL Colorado State Patrol personnel have left the facility & the gates have been opened by race personnel.

Eligibility: USAC License Required. USAC 1-Day *Beginner* license: \$10, only for Cat 5 men, Cat 4 Women and Juniors who have never previously held a USAC license with a higher category. Pre-registration will require an One-day license available onsite for race day registration. **BRAC annual membership recommended** to avoid BRAC 1-Day membership (\$5) on race day. (BRAC 1-Day Membership exempt with USAC 1-Day and out-of-state racers). BRAC Annual Memberships available online at www.coloradocycling.org

Registration: Pre-register online at <http://peaktopeak.trainingiltapp.com/>. Walk up registration is also welcome on day of race at the race site. No refunds allowed unless there is a weather related race cancellation in which we will offer a transfer of race fee to a later date or a refund minus fee's. All registration USAC paperwork must be properly filled out & signed including the CSP release form available at the race site.

BRP INFO: ONLY HELD ON 6/8, 6/22, 7/6, 7/27, 8/3, 2016. Clinic for beginner/Cat 4/5 racers begins at 6:00 pm with their race joining the regular Category 4-5's beginning at 7:10 pm. Coaches will access skills during the clinic and race with a final post meeting afterwards. Please visit the BRP page on BRAC's & USAC websites.

Walk up registration closes 10 minutes prior to the start of each race.

On-line registration closes 3 hours prior to the start of each race.

Entry Fee: (includes ACA surcharges) \$8 per race for juniors on-site only**
\$23 per race for adults

Cash, check or credit cards will be accepted at the race site this year.

Rules: Each race is a combined race for best sprinter and for best finisher. Series points will be awarded for top 5 places on designated laps and for top 10 places at the finish. P,1,2,3's race 16 laps; Cat 4/5's race 12 laps. **Juniors:** Gear restrictions apply to all juniors they may race in appropriate categories as listed on their licenses. See rules 1M6 & 1M7 for clarification. FREE LAP RULE WILL BE IN EFFECT.

Awards: Medals & Prizes for best OVERALL finisher (total accumulated points from sprints and finishes).
