Lookout Mountain Hill Climb Saturday March 19



This event is a Rocky Mountain Road Cup event.

Directions: From Denver take 6th Ave. west to 19th St. in Golden and turn left. From Boulder take Highway 93 to 19th St. and turn right. Continue on 19th St. for one mile to the start. Parking is to the left of the start. Please show respect for area residents and observe NO PARKING areas. Construction will be occurring at the intersection of 6th Ave. and 19th St. Please use caution and plan for delayed traffic.

Course: A four mile individual time trial on the legendary Lookout Mountain. Start at the pillars and finish at Buffalo Bill's Grave.

Oredigger Street Sprints Saturday March 19

This is a collegiate only event.

Directions: From Denver take 6th Ave. west to 19th St. in Golden and turn right. From Boulder take Highway 93 to 19th St. and turn left. Take left at first light onto Illinois St.

Course: A straight, 400 meter sprint with a steep hill. Racers will compete four at a time in a bracket style event until a winner is determined.

Start Times: Races will begin at 4:30 PM with Women's C. Start times will vary based on the number of competitors.

Oredigger Classic Criterium Sunday March 20

This event is not a Rocky Mountain Road Cup event.

Directions: From Denver take 6th Ave. west to 19th St. in Golden and turn right. From Boulder take Highway 93 to 19th St. and turn left. Take first left onto Elm St. for Start Finish. Construction will be occurring at the intersection of 6th Ave. and 19th St. Please use caution and plan for delayed traffic.

Course: A 1.1 km course along the School of Mines Greek row and intramural fields with a short, steep climb.

Entry Fees

Collegiate:

\$25 each for Hill Climb and criterium. \$5 for street sprints.

Non-Collegiate:

\$35 for Hill Climb. \$35 for criterium. \$15 for juniors.

Registration

There is no registration on race day for the Hill Climb. Criterium registration will close 30 minutes before the start of each category. Registration can be found online at www.usacycling.org. Online registration will close Wednesday March 17, 2016. Start times will be posted by midnight on March 18 at <http://recsports.mines.edu/REC-Club-Sports-Cycling-Road>. The Lookout Mountain Hill Climb is a Rocky Mountain Road Cup Event. The Oredigger Classic Criterium is not a Rocky Mountain Road Cup Event.

Licenses

Collegiate:

Riders must have a USAC collegiate license.

Non-Collegiate:

USAC license required for all USAC categories. All licenses can be purchased at www.usacycling.org. 1-day licenses available at race site for \$10.00. (USAC 1-days only available to Cat 5 men and Cat 4 women who did not previously hold a USAC license with a higher category).

BRAC annual membership recommended at USAC races to avoid \$5.00 1-day BRAC membership. (BRAC 1-day membership fee waived w/USAC 1-Day license). BRAC memberships can be purchased at www.coloradocycling.org.

Prizes

\$350 will be distributed to the top five riders in the Pro-1-2 men's Hill Climb and \$300 will be distributed to the top three Pro-1-2 women's Hill Climb.

\$200 will be distributed to the top five riders in the Pro-1-2 men's and women's criteriums.
