BRAC annual membership recommended to avoid BRAC 1-Day membership (\$5) on race day. (BRAC 1-Day membership exempt with USAC 1-Days and Out-of-State riders). BRAC Championship Medal and Jersey Eligibility

All participants must hold a valid USAC road license. Only current USAC annual licensees who are USA citizens or permanent residents and reside in the local association area known as BRAC as shown on their license are eligible to compete for the State (BRAC) Championship Title. Additionally, to receive the Champion jersey you must be a current annual member of BRAC. Professional men and women are welcome to race, but are not eligible for State (BRAC) Championship title, medal or jersey.



Road Cup Senior Groups: SM Pro-1-2, SM 3, SM 4, SW Pro-1-2, SW 3 & SW 4.

Road Cup Master Groups: MM 40+ 1-2-3, MM 40+ 3, MM 40+ 4, MM 50+ 1-2-3, MM 50+ 4, MM 60+, MM 70+, WM 40+, WM 50+, WM 60+

All USAC Rules Apply.

CENTERLINE RULE STRICTLY ENFORCED – Stay in right lane at all times or get DQ'd.

HELMETS REQUIRED.

No EarBuds/Radios/iPods

Race will only be cancelled due to weather conditions that may be dangerous to riders.
