USA Cycling Racing Rules Apply



Location: North of Fort Collins at the Buckeye Exit off Interstate 25
Follow I-25 to exit 288. Follow the signs to parking. No parking on course.

Entry: USAC = \$30.00 + \$3.60 on-line fee. Collegiate = MUST REGISTER AT RACE

No mail in USAC registration – must register on-line – <http://www.usacycling.org/>
Collegian Racers must register & pick up numbers and do paperwork for the season at the TT.

On-line registration closes Thursday, March 3rd, 10PM MST. No Refunds.



USA Cycling License and BRAC membership required. Collegiate license is needed for the collegiate events. No annual licenses/memberships sold on race day – purchase at: <http://www.usacycling.org/> and <http://www.coloradocycling.org/>

“One Day” USAC Licenses will be available only for SM 5, Jrs, SW 4 (may only be purchased by those that never had a USAC license with a higher category. \$10.00.

USAC 1-Day *Experienced* license: \$25, available only once/year to former USAC members-category 1,2,3,4 men/boys and category 1,2,3 women/girls and must be purchased online at USAC

“One Day” BRAC memberships available for everyone - \$5.00 **It is highly that you purchase an annual USAC and BRAC membership before race day to (it can get cold standing inline!).**

Course: An out and back approximately 11.4 miles distance over mostly flat terrain hills. The course is on the East service road between exits 288 and 281 and is entirely melting sun’s rays.

NO USAC Race Day Registration! Number pick-up opens at 8:00 AM. You must pick up number 30 minutes before your start. First rider is off at 9:00 AM. Riders leave at 30 second intervals according to category. Road is open to traffic – stay right.

Collegiate racers must register race day. No collegiate on-line registration

Start times will be posted at <http://www.coloradocycling.org/> by Friday evening.

Prizes: USAC only to top three places in each category as shown below –divided by “/”

Special Individual TT Rule: Riders may race in the category they are eligible for or higher
