USAC Waiver-must be signed by all racers or parent/guardian for anyone 18 & under.

Spectators: Road will be closed to traffic at 9am. Leave prior to race start. Do not park in any of the Forest Service Campgrounds.

Time Cutoff is in effect. If you are not at the "day parking" at the upper USFS lot within one hour and 15 minutes, you can be pulled from the race.

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

The 11mile course rises 3150 ft. from Georgetown with grades of 8-12%. Finish at 11,700 ft. in west parking lot on top of pass. Roads will be open to traffic. Riders descending back to Georgetown are expected to follow all traffic laws.

USAC License Required:

USAC 1-Day *Beginner* license: \$10, only for Cat 5 men, Cat 4 Women, Citizens, Tandem, and juniors.

Citizens' race: Men and Women starts at 9:17am



DIRECTIONS:

Denver: I-70 to Exit 283. East on 15th St., exit out of the left side of the roundabout on Argentine St. Drive 1/2 mile on Argentine to Georgetown Lake. **Race parking** in the dirt lot off of 22nd St. Please avoid warming up on the road, bring a trainer.

Race Start: All riders will line up in respective categories at Georgetown Lake and will roll out together at 8:55am to the starting area at City Park in Georgetown where the awards will be located after the race. First category will start from the park at 9am with subsequent categories leaving every minute after.

Support: Bring warm clothes for the descent, there can still be snow on the pass in June. Clothing vehicles at registration will transport clothing to finish. No wheel support, bring a tube. No hand ups allowed. No parents can ride along with junior racers.

Rules: All BRAC/USAC rules apply. Ascending lane will be closed to traffic. Center-line rule strictly enforced.

Descent is open to traffic. On the descent, stay to the right and obey all traffic laws through town. Respect our National Forest, DO NOT LITTER. Littering, yellow line rule violations and failure to obey traffic laws on your return to Georgetown are grounds for DQ

Awards: At City Park, site of staging area 11-2pm.
