Entry Fee Omnium entry is \$120 (all races), after April 1st \$135, after May 1st \$150. TT only \$30, Circuit only \$40. Road race only \$70. Time Trial, Circuit Race and Road Race price increases \$5 after May 1st. Jr's 15-18 All 3 Races \$65 before May 1, and \$75 after May 1. Individual races: TT \$20, Crit \$25, Road Race \$35, Price increases \$5 after May 1 for TT & Circuit Races, and \$10 for Road Race. JR's 13-14 Road Race \$15, after 5/1 \$20.

Juniors 9-12 FREE For Road Race Entry. Pre-reg surcharge for online reg.

Pre Registration for the 3 day omnium package saves you the most \$\$\$.** All riders will be entered into the omnium competition even if you only race one day and do race day registration for Saturday & Sunday's races.

Fine Print See website for Tech Guide. All USA Cycling Rules apply. Held rain or shine. **USAC License Required-** USAC 1-Day Beginner license: \$10, only for Cat 5 men, Cat 4 Women and Juniors who have never held a USAC license. Can **only** be purchased online at www.usacycling.org/events/?state=CO, select appropriate event, then click on Purchase One-Day License. Bring receipt to race. Annual licenses available online at USACYCLING.ORG

BRAC annual, go to www.coloradocycling.org (\$25), promoting club: Without Limits.

Chip Timing This will be a Race Rite Chip Timed Event. You will not need to pay extra for a chip. You'll pick up your timing chip at registration (ankle strap) and return it following your race. \$35 fee for unreturned chips. Saturday will NOT be Chip Timed.

Location See Website for Details, TT-Superior Marketplace, Circuit- on top of the Wall, RR @ Community Park, Superior, CO. Travel Highway 36 north of Denver, exit at the Superior exit, McCaslin Blvd. Head south on McCaslin, make a left on Rock Creek Parkway, continue down the hill to Coalton Drive and follow signs to parking.

Morgul Bismarck Road Race, Sunday

The 13.3 mile loop has 750 vertical feet of elevation gain with significant grades and the finish at the top of the 'Wall'.

- Start will be at Community Park, finish at top of the McCaslin. Course uses McCaslin Blvd, Hwy 128, Hwy 93, Marshall Rd, 76th St, W Coal Creek.
- Riders must stay inside cone lane when it's present. Centerline Rule on all roads except McCaslin up The Wall leading to the finish.
- Riders falling outside of published time cut (TBD) will be pulled and given a pro-rated finish time.
- Neutral feedzone on hump on McCaslin Blvd.
- **Limited neutral support provided by roving race trucks**
- JR rollout applies to all JR's regardless of race group entered. **NOTE: Must be present at award ceremony to receive \$\$ and awards.** "/" indicates separate prizes for each of those categories
