Three days of action packed bike racing in a time based stage race format, but with the ability to also pick and choose to race one or two days should you not want to be a part of the time based stage race.

Stage Race racers only receive BRAC cup points.

The 2017 Boulder Stage Race brings to Colorado three exciting venues, courses, and a format attractive to all type racers. Friday's race will kick things off with a hill climb race against the clock as riders tackle the race of truth up to el Dora ski area. On Saturday riders will battle the clock once more for a 10 mile flat to gently rolling time-trial race in northern Boulder County. Then it all comes down to the road race on Sunday for a race that everyone can enjoy, a strong rider type course from Lyons to Ward to Nederland.

How does this time-based stage race format work? All USAC Stage Race Rules apply! If you want to be a part of the time based stage race you must pre-register using the stage race race registration link and you'll be signed up for all three days. You must race and finish all three days to be scored in the final stage race overall race results. You will pick up one chip and one number for the weekend and must pay for lost chip.

I only want to race the time-trial, or road race, or two out of the three days, how does that work? Easy! For the two time-trial races you must pre-register. For the road race you can either pre-register just for those events or take advantage of race day registration, but will NOT be scored in the overall stage race. You'll be scored against all the competitors for that day like it's a normal single day event with single event prizes.

I'm racing the stage race (all three days), but 10 guys who just signed up for the single day beat me. How will this affect my stage race results? The people who beat you that were registered for the single day will not show up in the stage race overall race results. ONLY athletes pre-registered in the stage race will be scored in the stage race.

DAY 1 – Friday Time Trial (Eldora Uphill Time Trial)- 6 miles

Start line: Nederland High School

Start times: are published on www.sanitascycling.com on site at the registration table and start line.

Please report to the start line no later than 10 minutes prior to your start time.

First rider will start at 4:00 PM. Riders departure in 30 sec intervals within a race group.

JR Rollout: Located next to number pick-up and stage race check-in at registration.

Number Placement: Number on the right hand side

Timing Chip: Athletes must pick up your timing chip with your race number and return at the conclusion of the race. Unreturned chips will be charged \$35 to the racer. NO CHIP = LAST PLACE Stage Race riders need to turn in chip each day and pick up new ones each day

Centerline Rule: Centerline Rule in effect for the entire course. If the centerline is crossed it will result in a disqualification and a stage racer will not be allowed to continue onto the next stage.

Neutral Support: none

Feed Zone: none

Time Bonuses: none

Protests: Protest period will close 15 minutes after results are posted

Results: Will be posted at the finish line following the completion of each rider in their particular category and live online

Awards: Awards will be available for pick-up on Saturday or Sunday at registration – no official podium ceremony, if not able to pick up time trial checks they can be mailed.

DAY 2 – Saturday Hygiene Time-Trial – 10 miles

Start line: located just west of railroad tracks on Hygiene Road, just west of 75th street. Please use street parking, and overflow in back of elementary school down the street to north.

Start times: are published www.sanitascycling.com and on site at the registration table and start line.

Please report to the start line no later than 10 minutes prior to your start time.

First rider will start at 8:00 AM. Riders departure in 30 sec intervals within a race group.

JR Rollout: Located next to number pick-up and stage race check-in at registration.

Number Placement: Number on the right hand side

Timing Chip: Athletes must pick up your timing chip with your race number and return at the conclusion of the race. Unreturned chips will be charged \$35 to the racer. NO CHIP = LAST PLACE all riders turn in chips and pick up new numbers before each stage

Centerline Rule: Centerline Rule in effect for the entire course. If the centerline is crossed it will result in a disqualification and a stage racer will not be allowed to continue onto the next stage. They are not able to continue or race the other stages as an overall but can race as a single day event at no charge.

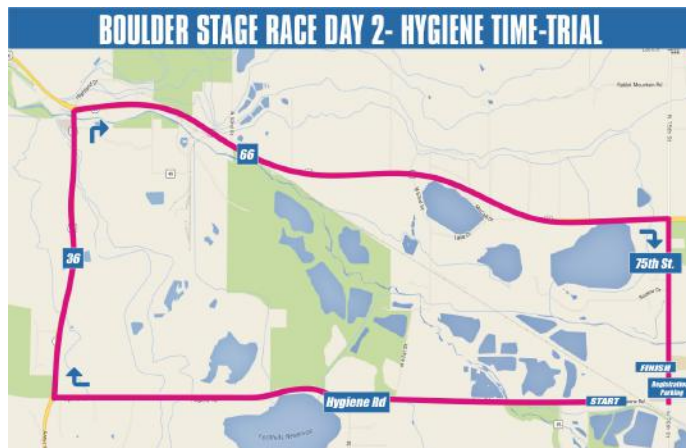

Start Line: Located at Sandstone Park in Lyons, Colorado. **Parking:** Street parking in an around Lyons

Stage Race Sign In: 6-6:50 at Sandstone Park, Lyons

JR Rollout: Located next to number pick-up and stage race sign-in at registration.

Number Placement: Two numbers, one on each side

Timing Chip: Athletes must pick up your timing chip with your race number and return at the conclusion of the race. Unreturned chips will be charged \$35 to the racer. NO CHIP = LAST PLACE

Center line rule: Center line rule in effect for all sections of this course. These roads are open to traffic so please abide by the double line rule. Please note that the sections are open to car traffic. There is an implied center line rule and racers must be aware of cars and traffic that could be on course at any time.

Neutral Support: We will have a neutral support vehicle following the riders, and one for each wave of riders. There is also a mechanical support area at staging and start area.

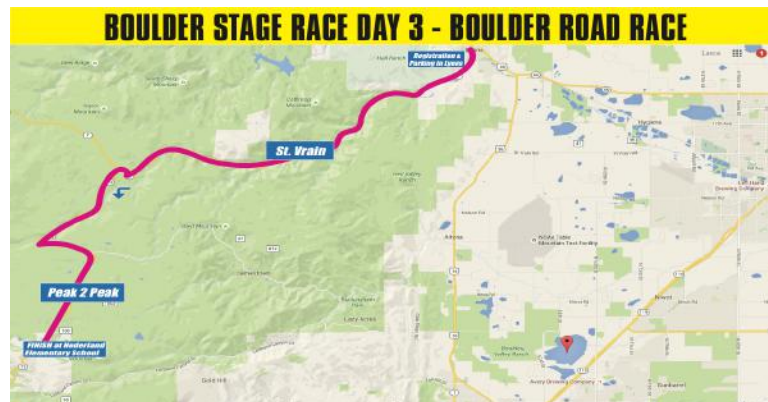
Feed Zone: There is no designated feed zone
