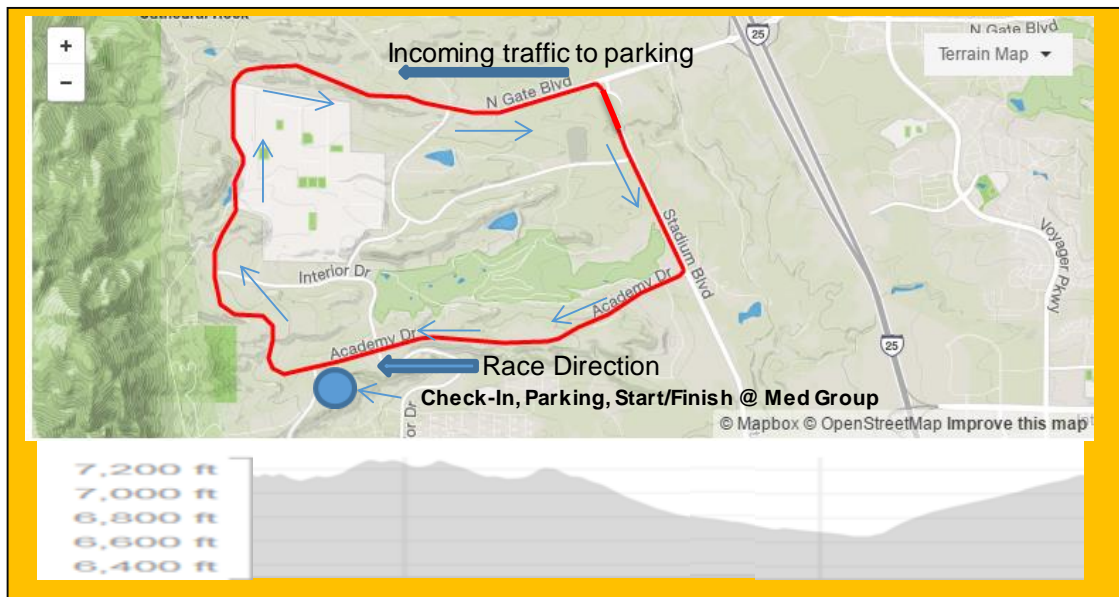

COURSE

Support

Wheel Support: Follow vehicle provided. Our wheel sponsor **ROL Wheels** will provide a limited number of neutral wheels. Otherwise, you **MUST** supply your own wheels with your race number & name clearly marked. Wheels marked for multiple racers must be marked with each racer's number. There will be an on-site mechanic provided by Criterium Bike Shop.

Feed Zone: Neutral bottles of water will be provided in the Feed Zone. Riders are only allowed to take Feeds in the designated Feed Zone, which will be located on the finishing climb.

Check-In/Number Pick-Up: Number pick-up will close **40 minutes** prior to the start of each wave. **Check-in early!**

Rules and Additional Information

- All USA Cycling rules apply. **Helmets** must be worn at all times.
- USAC Release waiver must be signed by all racers, or parent/legal guardian for anyone 18 years or younger.
- Gear restrictions apply to all Juniors (9-18). See USAC Rule 114.
- Bike restriction apply to Juniors 14 and under. See USAC Rule 115.
- BRAC annual membership recommended to avoid BRAC 1-Day membership (\$5) for race day (BRAC 1-Day membership exempt with USAC 1-Day license & out-of-state racers). A BRAC annual membership is required for BRAC CUP points.
- **USAC License Required.** The 1-Day USAC license (\$10) may only be bought by Juniors & Cat 5 Men/Women.
- USAC and BRAC 1-Day licenses may be purchased during online registration.
- Only current USAC annual licensees who are USA citizens or permanent residents and reside in the local association area known as BRAC as shown on their license are eligible to compete for the State (BRAC) Championship Title. Riders on UCI professional teams are welcome to race, but are not eligible for State (BRAC) Championship title, medal or jersey.
- All roads are open to traffic. If there is no painted centerline, riders **MUST** keep to the right, leaving a clear passing lane. **CENTERLINE RULE STRICTLY ENFORCED.** There will be no warning. Violations result in disqualification.
- Emergency medical care will be on-site and staged around the course.
- Race will be cancelled only if weather conditions exist that may endanger riders.
- Absolutely no littering or tossing bottles on course except in designated Feed Zone.
- Absolutely no public urination or nudity--Automatic Disqualification.
- All races are BRAC CUP races. State Championship races earn an additional 50% more CUP points.



Results and Prizes

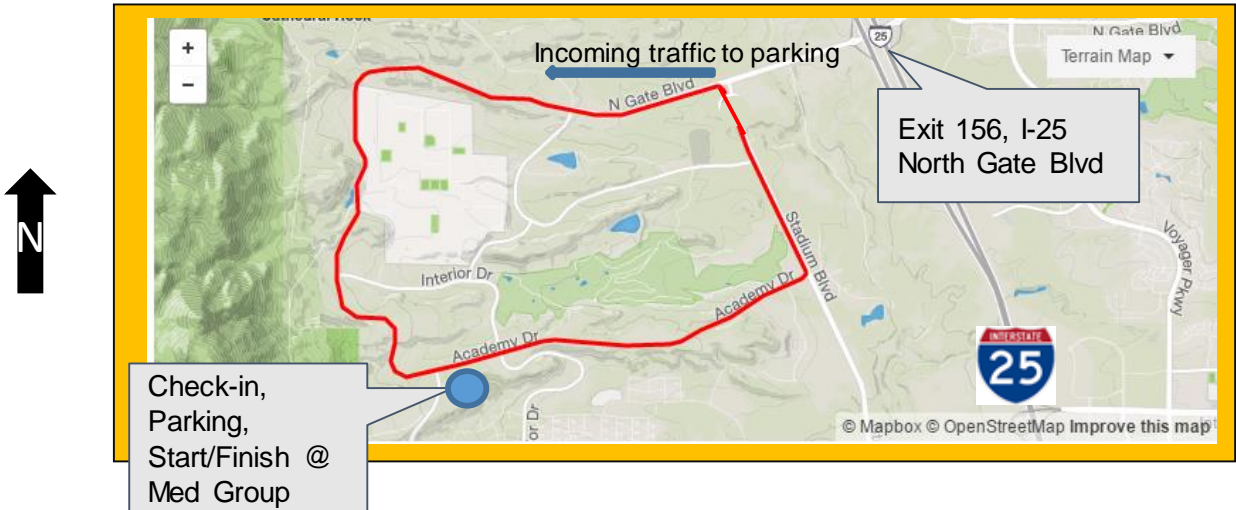
- Results will be posted near registration tables.

Access, Directions, and Parking

Note: Access is only through the North Gate. To access North Gate between 6:00 AM - 7:59 AM, riders **MUST** submit their **Date of Birth & Driver's License number** during online registration....This applies to racers with start times before 10:30 AM.

Arrive Early! Expect delays and vehicle searches at North Gate entrance.

I-25, Exit 156. Enter USAFA through the North Gate (open to the public at 6am). You must have a valid driver's license or government issued ID. Proceed straight (west) on North Gate Rd, all the way around the back to the parking lot located at the Medical Center - 4102 Pinion Dr, USAFA, CO 80840.
