**COURSE DESCRIPTION:**

The 11mile course rises 3150 ft. from Georgetown with grades of 8-12%. Finish at 11,700 ft. in west parking lot on top of pass. Roads will be open to traffic. Riders descending back to Georgetown are expected to follow all traffic laws

**USAC License Required.** USAC 1-Day *Beginner* license: \$10, only for Cat 5 men/women. Can be purchased online at [https://legacy.usacycling.org/events/state\\_search.php?state=CO](https://legacy.usacycling.org/events/state_search.php?state=CO), select appropriate event, then click on Purchase One-Day License. Bring receipt to race.

USAC 1-Day *Experienced* license: \$25, only available to former USAC members-category 1,2,3,4 men/women, and must be purchased online at same link as indicated for *Beginner* license.

**BRAC annual membership recommended to avoid \$5 onsite fee.** BRAC 1-day membership \$5, available on site (BRAC 1-day membership exempt with USAC 1-day or out of state USAC license holder. Annual memberships available online at [www.coloradocycling.org](http://www.coloradocycling.org)

BRAC annual membership is required to obtain points for RMRC competitions.

**Denver:** : I-70 to Exit 283. East on 15th St., exit out of the left side of the roundabout on Argentine St. Drive 1/2 mile on Argentine to Georgetown Lake.

**Field Limit Size:** Refer to chart above

**PARKING:** The dirt lot off of 22nd St. Please avoid warming up on the road, bring a trainer.

**CHIP TIMING:** This will be a chip timed event.
