PRE-REGISTRATION: Available 8/1 and closes Wed 11/28 at 11:59pm [ADULTS: \$40, Juniors 9-10: \$10, Juniors 11-18: \$20]

RACE DAY REGISTRATION: Adults & Jr's racing in adult category: \$50 Juniors 9-10: \$15, Juniors 11-18: \$25]

Race day Registration Opens: 6:30 am & closes 40 min. prior to race start [Note: pre-registered athletes need to pick up # 40min prior to start]

2nd Race: is \$15 available online or race day | **Field Limit Size:** 125 per wave | **Refunds:** No refunds

TIMING: This event will be timed with a high speed camera

AWARDS: Athletes must be present to receive their awards or prize money (prize money will not be mailed)

CALL-UPS: Based on USA Cycling rankings **COURSE PREVIEW:** Use bypass lane by finish line, only allowed on course when GREEN Flag is flying

Venue Location: Salisbury Equestrian Park 11920 Motsenbocker Rd, Parker, CO 80134

Denver & Boulder: : Head south on I-25 to Lincoln Rd, East to Jordan Rd., South to Hess Road, East to Motsenbocker Rd., North past the Main entrance to the park

Parking: Parking will be in the main dirt lot at the park - please follow the parking signs into the venue

USA Cycling License Required: USAC 1-Day Beginner license: \$10, only for Cat 5 Men, Cat 5 Women and Jrs who have never held a USA Cycling License. Can be purchased online at www.usacycling.org/events/?state=CO, select appropriate event, then click on Purchase One-Day License. Bring receipt to race. **Annual USA Cycling licenses available online at www.usacycling.org**

Race Rules: All USA Cycling Rules Apply **USA Cycling Permit #:** 2018-1883

State Championship Race Info: Only current USAC annual licensees who are USA citizens or permanent residents and reside in the local association area known as BRAC as shown on their license are eligible to compete for the State Championship Title

BRAC (Local USA Cycling Association for Colorado) annual membership: Recommended to avoid \$5 one-day onsite fee. BRAC 1-day membership \$5, available on site (BRAC 1-day membership exempt with USA Cycling 1-day or out of state USA Cycling license holder)
