Centennial Loop – A .7 mi loop encompassing Centennial Pkwy, West Century Dr. & Century Pl. Fast Downhill turn & gradual leg burning power climb to a sprint finish.

**Race Rules: All USAC Rules Apply
USAC License Required:**

USAC 1-Day Beginner license: USAC 1-Day *Beginner* license: \$10, only for Cat 5 men/women. Can be purchased online at https://legacy.usacycling.org/events/state_search.php?state=CO, select appropriate event, then click on Purchase One-Day License. Bring receipt to race if registering on race day

USAC 1-Day Experienced license: \$25, only available to former USAC members- category 1,2,3,4 men/women, and must be purchased online at same link as indicated for *Beginner* license.

Denver: Highway 36 towards Boulder, exit at the Superior/McCaslin Blvd. Exit. Head North on McCaslin at 4th light, make a left on Centennial Parkway

Ft. Collins: I-25 S. to Diagonal, South on S. Hover Rd/N 95th St. Right onto S. Boulder Rd, Left on McCaslin, Right onto Centennial Pkwy.

Boulder: Highway 36 towards Denver, exit at the Superior/McCaslin Blvd. Exit. Head North on McCaslin at 4th light, make a left on Centennial Parkway
