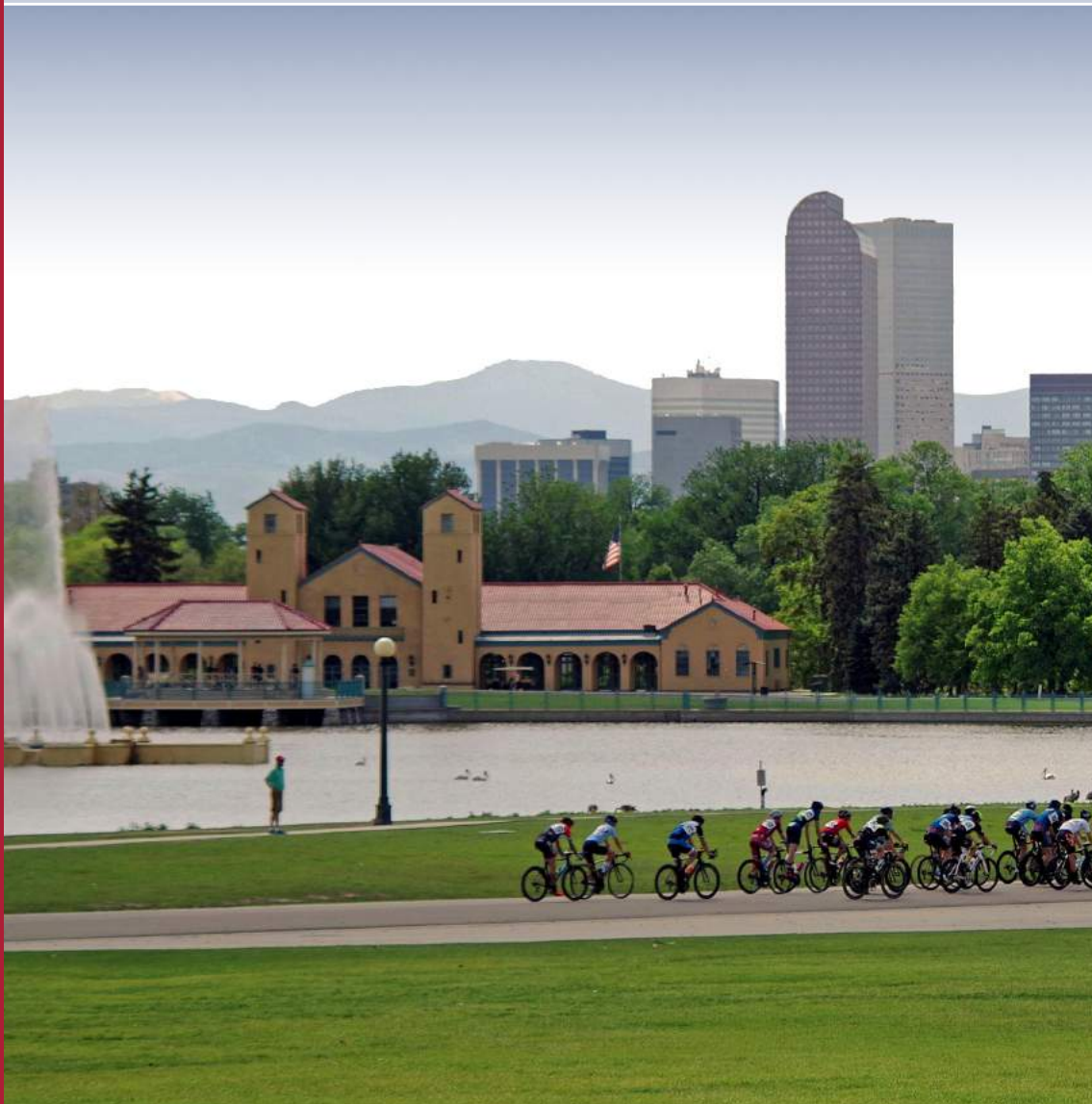

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HELLO BIKE RACERS AND FANS,

I am excited to tell you that we have some changes for this year's race, which I think you will find to be vast improvements over years past. We have been working as a team to try to improve the race experience for everyone involved.

IF YOU ARE NEW TO RACING WE ARE HOLDING TWO BEGINNER CLINICS, ONE FOR THE WOMEN AND ONE FOR THE MEN.

The men's clinic begins at 7:00 am and will include 15 minutes of theory and 15 minutes of practice on the race course. The beginner men's race begins at 7:30 am (M 4-5 / M 15-16 / M 17-18). It is a good idea to arrive an hour early to register for your race, and for the clinic. (6:00 am) There is no fee for the clinic. Registration closes 40 minutes prior to each race.

The women's clinic begins at 7:50 am and will have 15 minutes of theory and 15 minutes of practice on the race course. Immediately following the clinic will be the women's beginner race (W 4-5 / W 15-16 / W 17-18). It is a good idea to arrive an hour early to register for your race and for the clinic. (6:50 am) You will need to register for the clinic. There is no fee for the clinic. Registration closes 40 minutes prior to each race.

NEW FOR THIS YEAR, WE HAVE MOVED THE START FINISH FROM THE WEST SIDE OF THE PARK TO THE PAVILIONS,

which is located more centrally in the park. If you have ever been to Jazz on the park the pavilions is where the stage is usually located. It is located on the west side of Ferril lake (paddle boats) and east of the Martin Luther King Jr. round about.

We have also added lots of parking in the park. The road where the old start finish was located is now available for parking. There are two ways to access this parking, you can enter from 23rd street just east of York going south or you can enter from 21st street and York.

IN ADDITION TO THIS WE HAVE A NEW SMOOTHER, MORE EXCITING COURSE.

We will be running the race clockwise this year instead of counter clockwise as in years past. Study the course map and come pre-ride the course. The new course has a better straighter sprint finish and we have eliminated pinch points and the hairpin turns.

WE WILL ALSO HAVE A COMPLEMENTARY BEER GARDEN COMPLEMENTS OF THE BULL AND BUSH PUB AND BREWERY!

This will be located in the Pavilions north of the Start Finish. There will also be food trucks and various bicycle vendors. Turin bicycle shop will be on site with some E-bikes for people to try out as well.
