2019 Table Mountain Race Series

Wednesday Evening Race Series: May 22, 29;

June 5, 12, 19,26; July 3, 10,17, 24, 31; August 7

Category 4-5's begin at **6:10 pm ~ 12 laps**

Category Pro-1-2-3's begin at **7:15 pm ~ 15 laps**

Location: Colorado State Patrol Training Facility, Golden, Colorado. From South Golden Road turn north on Quaker Street through open green gates where pavement ends & dirt begins. Follow this dirt road up hill to top of Table Mountain where pavement resumes. Parking is allowed on this road & up to 100 foot before the race track.

Track Access not available until after ALL Colorado State Patrol personnel have left the facility & the gates have been opened by race personnel. Do not enter the gates until confirmation.

Eligibility: CURRENT USAC License Required. USAC 1-Day *Beginner* license: \$10, only for Cat 5 men, Cat 5 Women and Juniors who have never previously held a USAC license. For those riders who have not renewed their licenses or are not current, a USAC 1-Day *Experienced* license is available for \$25. Both One-day licenses will be available onsite for purchase in addition to the race entry fee. **BRAC annual membership recommended** to avoid BRAC 1-Day membership (\$5) on race day. (BRAC 1-Day Membership exempt with USAC 1-Day **and** out-of-state racers). BRAC Annual Memberships available online at www.coloradocycling.org

Registration: Walk up registration **ONLY** on day of race at the race site. You may register for future races at race site, but mail in or online registration is not offered. No refunds allowed unless there is a weather related race cancellation in which we will offer a transfer of race fee to a later date or a refund minus fee's. All registration USAC paperwork & CSP release form must be properly filled out & signed available at the race site and downloadable online at <https://peaktopeak.trainingiltapp.com>

BRP INFO: ONLY HELD ON May 29, June 12, 26, July 10, 24. Clinic for beginner/Cat 4/5 racers begins at 6:00 pm. Coaches will access skills during the clinic and race with a final post meeting afterwards. Please visit the BRP page on BRAC's & USAC websites.

Walk up registration closes 10 minutes prior to the start of each race.

Entry Fee: (includes BRAC surcharges) \$10 per race for juniors on-site only**
\$25 per race for adults

Cash, check or credit cards will be accepted at the race site this year.

Rules: Each race is a combined race for best sprinter and for best finisher. Series points will be awarded for top 5 places on designated laps and for top 10 places at the finish. P,1,2,3's race 15 laps; Cat 4/5's race 12 laps.

Juniors: Gear restrictions apply to all juniors they may race in appropriate categories as listed on their licenses. See rules 1M6 & 1M7 for clarification. **FREE LAP RULE WILL BE IN EFFECT.**

Awards: Awards for best OVERALL finisher (total accumulated points from sprints and finishes).
