Categories shown in red are CO State championship races. To be eligible, riders must hold USAC and BRAC annual license, be US Citizens or permanent residents, and reside in the area known as BRAC (CO and southern WY) as shown on their licenses. Professional riders are welcome but are not eligible for championship medals.

Course Description: The .7 mile "L" shaped course is mostly flat and winds around shady, historic Thompson Park. The start/finish area and registration is located near the intersection of Pratt & 4th.

Race Rules: All USAC rules apply. Free lap until 5 laps to go. On-course warm up limited to 1 lap between events.

Registration: Preregistration is available at usacycling.org until 11:59 p.m. Friday, July 12, 2019. Online \$35. \$45 race day. Fee for second race is \$15. Entry fee includes USAC Insurance and USAC LA surcharges. Race will run regardless of weather conditions. Race day registration opens at 6:40 a.m. and closes 40 min prior to each race.

USAC License Required: License must be presented on race day. All USAC licenses available online at www.usacycling.org (Annual & 1-day for experienced or beginner racers) Beginner 1-day license (\$10) available onsite - only Cat 5 Men/Women/Jrs. w/ no prev. higher Cat USAC license.

BRAC Annual membership: Recommended to avoid BRAC 1-Day membership (\$5) on race day (available on site). (BRAC 1-Day Membership exempt with USAC 1-Day, Out-of- State riders). BRAC annual membership is required to obtain points for BRAC CUP competitions. BRAC annual available at: www.coloradocycling.org

Directions to Thompson Park: 1-25 to CO 119 exit. Take 119 West to 3rd Ave. Turn right/north on 3rd Ave. Continue one block west of Main Street. Turn right/north on Coffman St. From Boulder: Diagonal Hwy/119 north to Hover Rd. Turn north on Hover to 3rd Ave. Turn right/East on 3rd Ave. Turn left on Coffman St

Parking: Parking is available on city streets and public lots but obey all parking laws and always respect local residents and businesses. You are welcome to warm up on the adjoining streets around the course, but rollers or trainers are recommended.

Festivities: For those of legal drinking age and carrying a valid government ID, our sponsor, Left Hand Brewing will be providing beer tasting in the beer tent. The Smother Food Truck will be selling their amazing food creations and other vendors will be present in shady, beautiful Thompson Park near the start/finish line. This is a great spectator event. And don't forget the Kids Race! Bring everyone!
