NOTE: **The Dirt Section is rougher than ordinary pavement. Bring suitable tires!**

Neutral Zone: There will be a neutral start (highlighted in blue) from the green dot (start line) until you turn right a second time, heading north on the frontage road. Racing begins on the frontage road. See map on page 2

Race Rules: All USAC Rules Apply

USAC 1-Day Beginner license: USAC 1-Day Beginner license: \$10, only for Cat 5 men/women and juniors. Can be purchased online at online at BikeReg when registering for race .

Annual USA Cycling licenses available online at www.usacycling.org

BRAC annual membership recommended to avoid \$5 1-day fee. BRAC 1-day membership \$5, available on site (BRAC 1-day membership exempt with USAC 1-day or out of state USAC license holder. Annual memberships available online at www.coloradocycling.org

Must be present to receive awards and/or prize money It will not be mailed

Lap Count: Since the start is on the opposite end of the course from the finish (Red Line), when you cross the finish line for the first time, your lap count will be (Example: if your field races 5 laps, it will actually be 5.5 laps total).

Parking and # pick-up: Event Parking and Registration for Cobb Lake will be at the Budweiser Headquarters Just west of the Richards Lake Rd and Busch Drive intersection in the North Construction Parking Lot. Please exit I-25 at the Mountain Vista Exit, then head North on Giddings Rd, then east on Richards Lake Rd to reach the parking lot.

Gear Restrictions apply to all juniors 9-18. See USAC Rule 114 (www.usacycling.org)

Bike Restrictions: apply to Jr's 14 & Under. See USAC Rule 115 (usacycling.org)
