**USA Cycling 1-Day Beginner license:**

USAC 1-Day Beginner license: \$10, only for Cat 5 men/women and juniors. Can be purchased online at [Bikereg.com](http://Bikereg.com) during the race registration process.

**BRAC annual membership recommended or you can purchase a \$5 1-day membership fee during registration process.**

**Note:** BRAC 1-day membership exempt with USAC 1-day license or out of state USAC license holder.

**USAC Waiver-**must be signed by all racers or parent/guardian for anyone 18&U during registration process

**State Championships Eligibility:** Colorado State Championship Eligibility Rule: All participants must hold a valid USAC road license. Only current USAC annual licensees who are USA citizens or permanent residents and reside in the local association area known as Colorado Cycling as shown on their license are eligible to compete for the State (Colorado Cycling) Championship Title. Riders on UCI professional teams are welcome to race, but are not eligible for State (Colorado Cycling) Championship title, medal or jersey

**Mechanical Support:** Limited neutral support provided by roving race trucks

**Race start & Finish:** Start and Finish will be 200m west of McCaslin Blvd on Highway 128.
